When I'm Afraid

Mark 4:1-2a; 35-41

Bible Memory Verse: "I can do all things through Him who gives me strength." ~ Philippians 4:13

Supplies needed for this lesson: Pencil

Have you ever been scared? Everyone has been scared at some point in their lives. In our Bible story today, we'll find out that even Jesus' disciples were scared! But first we're going to talk a little more about situations that might scare us.

Print the worksheet called Scary Squares from the end of this lesson plan. Choose at least one picture (you can do two or three or even all four!) and answer the questions listed at the top of the page in the square below the picture(s) you chose. What are some scary things you've faced? What do you do to get help when you are afraid?

It's good to have someone to help us when we're afraid. Today's Bible story teaches us who we can call on anytime we are afraid. Click on the link below to watch a video of our true Bible story from the book of Mark. You can also read the story with your family from pages 2 and 3 of *Bible Discoveries* at the end of this lesson plan.

So, even the disciples, who had watched Jesus do many miracles, were afraid of the storm and amazed that Jesus had power over the wind and the waves. Jesus is all-powerful (even more than a superhero!) and He loves us so much that He doesn't want us to be afraid. When we are facing something scary, we can remember that Jesus is in control of everything and we can call on Him to help us find peace during our "storms".

Next let's turn to page 4 in our *Bible Discoveries*. Follow the instructions at the top of the page to complete the activity. Jesus will be there whenever we are afraid.

For our final activity today, turn to page 1 of your Bible Discoveries. God helped His people when they were afraid throughout the Bible. Use your knowledge of stories we have learned in the past to answer the questions in the crossword puzzle. There is a word bank on the right side if you need a little help.

Jesus can help when we are afraid. We don't always know how He will help us but we know that He can. Put your Bible Discoveries someplace special at home to remind you of the different ways Jesus can help you when you're afraid.

Let's end our lesson today with a prayer of thanks that Jesus can help when we are afraid.

Prayer:



One day Jesus was teaching. He was by the Sea of Galilee.










All of us have times when we are afraid. Jesus has the power to help us handle the scary times.

- Ignore them and maybe they'll forget.






What could steven do?
