### Applying Today's Sermon to Your Life

- 1. Today's Bible study is from the first book of the Bible, Genesis. The key people in the fifty chapters of Genesis are Adam and Eve, Noah, Abraham, Isaac, Jacob and Joseph. Write a short paragraph overviewing this Book of Genesis and include all seven of these people in your paragraph. Our Verse-of-the Week is John 3:16, "For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life."
- 2. Commit the names of the 39 Old Testament books to memory this week. Note these five categories to help you remember them, using 5-12-5-5-12:
- ...5 Books of Moses, or Books of Law, or Pentateuch
- ...12 Books of History
- ...5 Books of Poetry, or Wisdom
- ...5 Books of Major Prophets, and
- ...12 Books of Minor Prophets, totaling 39!
- 3. Romans 15:4, in the New Testament, speaks of the Old Testament, saying, "For everything that was written in the past was written to teach us, so that through endurance and the encouragement of the Scriptures we might have hope." What specific values to the Christian are surfaced in today's Bible study?
- 4. I Corinthians 10:11, in the New Testament, speaks of Old Testament events, saying, "These things happened to them as examples and were written down as warnings for us." How are you inspired by today's examples and warnings?
- 5. Our Bible study is about People of the Bible. Have you ever heard today's Scripture text? How does it apply to your walk with Christ this week?
- 6. How does Isaac's question in Genesis 22:7, "Where is the Lamb?", become the theme of the Old Testament now? Consider John 1:29 in your answer! Who is our ultimate Lamb of God?
