

During our recent mission trip to the Dominican Republic, I had the opportunity to experience worship in a way that moved me deeply—not because of a fancy band or high-end production, but because of the heart behind it.

The church we visited was humble. Worship was led by two people, with a computer and projector playing YouTube videos. That's it. And yet, the voices of that small congregation—which was probably doubled in size by our team—rose with more volume and passion than I've heard on many Sundays in our own building. They were singing their hearts out... to some of the same exact songs our congregation was singing hundreds of miles away that morning!

Colossians 3:16 says, "Let the message of Christ dwell among you richly... singing to God with gratitude in your hearts." That's what we witnessed that morning. They weren't waiting for the "right vibe" or a full band. They came ready to worship—to mean it.

It made me think... how often do I let my preferences get in the way of my praise? Am I focused more on the heart of worship, or on my performance?

I came home reminded: worship isn't about the setup. It's about the Savior. And a heart full of gratitude is louder than any sound system.



Because of this incredible outpouring of support, we were able to do far more than expected:

- Fund the well installation
- Finish the bathroom at the church
- Drywall and paint the entire ceiling
- Paint the stage and sound booth
- Build a tool shed to store supplies for future mission projects and much more!

We were also pleasantly surprised when the team from the well company showed up early to begin the project! Our second ACC mission team was on-site, and a few of our own guys even got to help start the digging process. What a memorable and meaningful moment to witness firsthand how this project is coming to life! We also heard from the church the well has water and the church already has access to it! 
