The Power of a Personal Invitation

This season has been a meaningful reminder of how powerful a simple invitation can be. In the weeks leading up to Christmas, moments like the choir and Christmas Around the Piano came together because people were willing to say yes—often after being personally invited. Many hadn't planned to participate or weren't sure they were "qualified," but an intentional invitation made space for them to step out in faith and share their gifts.

There's something uniquely encouraging about being personally invited. It communicates belonging and value, and it reminds people that they are seen. Often, that invitation becomes the gentle nudge someone needs to take a step they've been quietly considering for a while. These moments also highlighted the impact of faithful volunteers. From rehearsals to behind-the-scenes support, worship is shaped by people who consistently give their time, energy, and hearts to serve others. Their faithfulness creates space for meaningful worship in ways that are deeply felt.

As we look ahead, experiences like these are shaping the vision for Worship Workshops in 2026—creating environments where people can grow, build confidence, and develop their gifts without pressure or perfection. This week, consider who God might be prompting you to personally invite—to serve, to sing, or simply to be part of what He's doing.
