





**My Spring Highlight** 

The highlight of my semester was praying with a student named Angela as she gave her life to Jesus. Angela found InterVarsity in January and she felt deeply loved by our community. She came to Bible discussions, prayer gatherings, campus outreaches, and weekend activities. She was like a sponge soaking up everything she could about Jesus. One day in February she came by our ministry table and asked if we could talk. She asked me all of her final questions about a relationship with Jesus. As we spoke I could sense the Holy Spirit drawing her in, so I asked if she would like to pray with me and ask Jesus to be her Lord. As we prayed in that moment,

the Fresno State free-speech area became Holy ground, solidifying my highlight experience of the semester. Here is the testimony she shared at our Large Group meeting a few weeks later.

"I've sought for love all my life. I wanted to know what it felt like to be loved unconditionally. With my family falling apart, I had felt so empty and depressed that I sought fulfillment in any way that I could. After witnessing the toxic relationship my parents had, I knew that was not something I wanted for myself.

Out of a fear of men I turned towards the wrong direction. I dated a woman for two years. I failed to recognize it then, but God was giving me signs to leave. Every act of jealousy, broken boundaries, and constant arguments pushed me further to the edge until I finally decided to end it for good. Then I was left empty again, not knowing what to do with myself or my life.

Prior to joining InterVarsity I'd only heard about God but never had a relationship with him. I believed in God but never had faith. InterVarsity changed that. Though my walk with God is still fairly new, my brothers and sisters have guided me so far in my journey. My heart and soul began to heal with repentance, prayer, worship, and Bible studies. I now know what true unconditional love feels like. I thank God for putting InterVarsity in my path. I've gained more than fellowship--I've gained a family."

I remember walking on campus two years ago with 6 students and some notebooks to give away. Our 2025 spring semester has ended, and I find myself in awe of all that Jesus has done! God has truly grown our ministry and impact on campus. Here's what I've seen God do:

- 2 Latino student gatherings
- A loving witnessing community of friends who invite and share the gospel

"After transferring to Fresno State from Fresno City College, I felt like I was on the right track, but something was clearly still missing. I had started to fall into the pattern from the previous two years where I would go to class and then go home immediately afterwards. My classes were good, but socially and spiritually I was severely lacking. I began to worry that I would be going through this year with no community around me. Thankfully, God had other plans for me. Mariah, a leader in InterVarsity, was at the table one day when I approached. We said hi and she told me about InterVarsity. Then she introduced me to Cole, and as we were both STEM majors and huge nerds, we immediately hit it off. He invited me to the Wednesday Bible study that he would be leading, and I agreed to go. 
