Ultrasound gave her clarity!

Client came into LIV undecided because she had been partying and drinking alcohol and was worried about the baby. When she first found out she was pregnant at home, she ordered the abortion pill. Then after sitting on it for a few days, she started to change her mind and became worried that she had damaged the



baby by drinking alcohol. She stated in her intake that she would keep the baby if it was alive in the ultrasound. Baby showed a strong heartbeat and we believe client intends to keep this pregnancy. She stated that the ultrasound gave her the clarity that she needed!

Ultrasounds are a powerful window into the development and life of an unborn baby. Most centers estimate that between 78%-80% of abortion minded/vulnerable women choose to keep their babies after an ultrasound.

Hilo Team Updates

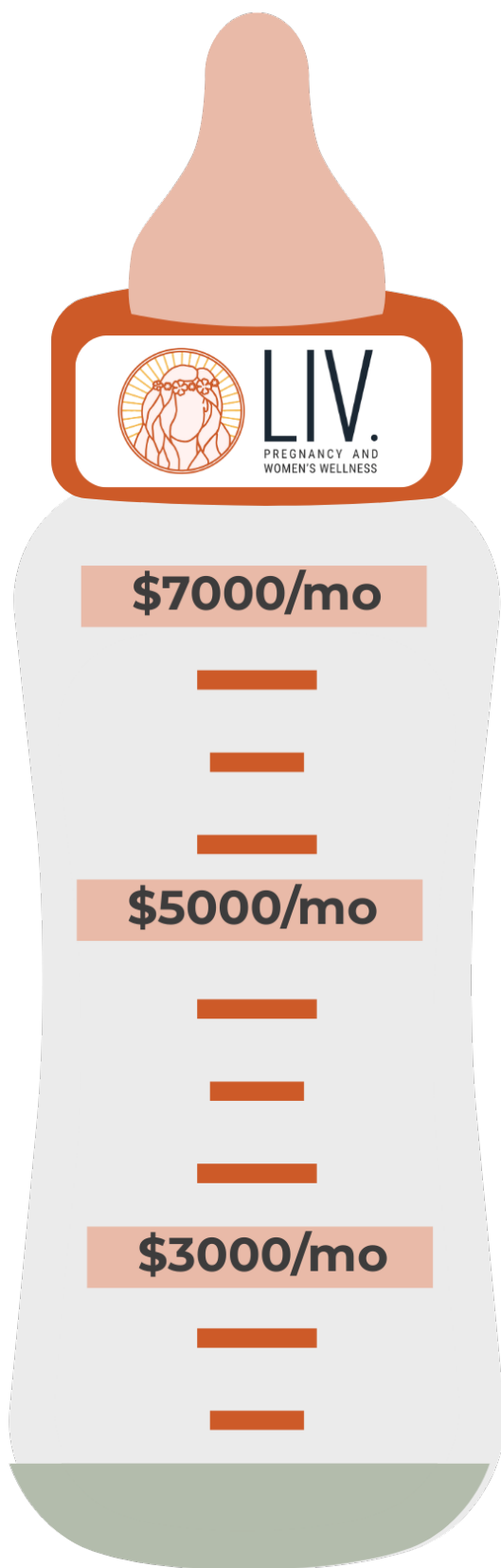
