Have You Taken Your Directory Picture Yet?

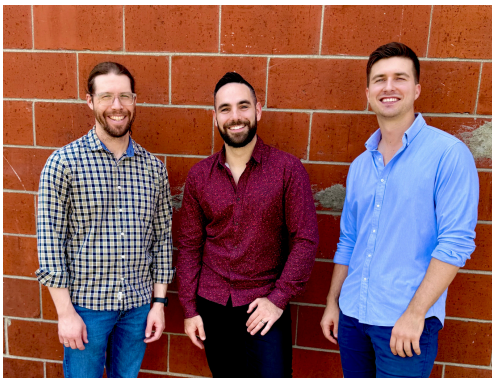
