## Week 11 | Holy Spirit

## What is the role of the Holy Spirit?

Jesus took time the night He was to be arrested toHis disciples (John 14-16).
Of all the things Jesus could have talked to them about, it was the that He emphasized with them.
Let me reread a verse we looked at in our last session. John 16:7.
"it is to your advantage that I go away, for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you. But if I go, I will send him to you."
As Christians, we also have the Holy Spirit living in us. There are three primary ways the Spirit helps us. First, The Holy Spirit e us permanently. We looked at that in the last session.
Second, The Holy Spirit e us spiritually. Third, the Holy Spirit e us for service.
How does the Holy Spirit encourage us? Jesus describes the Spirit as the "" (John 14:6, 26; 15:26; 16:7) and "" (John 14:7; 16:13).
"Helper" in the Greek language of the New Testament can also be translated Counselor, Comforter, or Advocate.
The Holy Spirit encourages us by our soul when going through <u>difficulties</u> . He can give a peace that passes all understanding.
The Holy Spirit encourages us by us towards wise decisions. The Holy Spirit will take God's Word and bring it to our attention when we make day to day decisions in our lives.

## The Holy Spirit helps us in prayer...

"Likewise the Spirit helps us in our weakness. For we do not know what to pray for as we ought, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us with groanings too deep for words. And he who searches hearts knows what is the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for the saints according to the will of God." Romans 8:26-27

Spiritual gifts are mentioned in Romans 12, 1 Corinthians 12, Ephesians and 1 Peter 4. Here is the full list of gifts mentioned in these passages: Prophesying, serving, teaching, encouraging, giving, leadership, mercy, words of wisdom/knowledge, faith, healing/miraculous powers, distinguishing between spirits, speaking in tongues, interpreting tongues helps, and administration.
Different views on spiritual gifts
Some churches teach that spiritual gifts are still in operation today while others teach that the "sign gifts" (prophecy, speaking in tongues, interpreting tongues, gift of healing) were gifts that were no longer needed once we had the
