Instructions:

As a family, work together to find each item and read the Bible verse that goes along with it. After reading, feel free to use the discussion questions to talk about the verse and how the item connects to it. You don't have to answer the questions for every item, they're simply there as a guide if you'd like!

For bonus points, take a picture of your family with each item as you find them. If you find all 12 items, you would have 12 different pictures with each item. We'll share these photos in a slideshow on Sunday and on our social media pages. The more creative and silly your pictures are, the better!

Items to find:

1. Piece of artwork or Drawing

Scripture: *Ephesians 2:10*

Discussion Questions:

Who made this artwork? How did they decide what it would look like?
What do you think it means that God made you on purpose?

2. Flashlight, lantern, or lamp

Scripture: *Psalm 119:105*

Discussion Questions:

What happens when we try to walk in the dark?
How does God's Word help guide us?
When do you think you might need God's light this week?

3. Shoes

Scripture: *Ephesians 6:15*

Discussion Questions:

Where do these shoes take you during the week?
What does it mean to be ready to show God's love wherever you go?
How can we share peace with others at school or home?

4. A mirror

Scripture: *Psalm 139:14*

Discussion Questions:

What do you see when you look in the mirror?
What does God say about you that's even more important than how you look?
How can we remind each other we're God's creation?

5. A Bible

Scripture: *2 Timothy 3:16*

Discussion Questions:

What is the Bible?
Why do you think God wants us to read His Word?
When is a good time our family could read the Bible together?

6. Bread

Scripture: *John 6:35*

Discussion Questions:

How does your body feel when you're hungry?
How does Jesus help us when our hearts feel empty?
What are some ways Jesus takes care of us?

7. A blanket

Scripture: *Psalm 91:4*

Discussion Questions:

How does a blanket make you feel?
When do you feel safe with God?
How can we trust God when we feel scared?

8. A cup or bottle of water

Scripture: *John 4:14*

Discussion Questions:

Why do we need water every day?
What do you think Jesus means by living water?
How can we stay close to Jesus every day?

9. A clock or watch

Scripture: *Ecclesiastes 3:1*

Discussion Questions:

What are some things we do at different times of the day?
Why do you think God cares about how we use our time?
What's one thing we can make time for with God this week?

10. Something broken that was fixed

Scripture: *Psalm 147:3*

Discussion Questions:

What was broken about this item?
How did it get fixed?
How does God help us when something in our hearts feels broken?

11. A candle or match

Scripture: *Matthew 5:14*

Discussion Questions:

What happens when light is in a dark room?
How can we be a light to other people?
Who do you know that needs kindness this week?

12. Something that helps you rest

Scripture: *Matthew 11:28*

Discussion Questions:

How does your body feel when it rests?
Why does God want us to rest?
How can we rest with God?
