LET'S GET STARTED!

- **Prayer Time:** Set aside time to pray in the morning or before bedtime!
- **Prayer Journal:** Use a journal to write or draw your prayers!
- **Prayer Space:** Create a quiet and cozy spot to help you focus as you pray!

Each day can be done in 5–10 minutes and is perfect for family devotions or for kids to try on their own.



WEEK 1: KNOWING GOD

Day 1: God is My Friend

“I no longer call you servants, because a servant does not know his master’s business. Instead, I have called you friends.” John 15:15

Today, we learn something wonderful – God wants to be our friend! Unlike the friendships we have with people, God’s friendship is truly special. Jesus tells us that He doesn’t just see us as people who follow rules or do tasks, but as friends He cares about deeply and wants to spend time with. Today, try to talk to God as you would with your best friend. Tell Him about your day, your worries, or your happy moments.

Remember, God is always there to listen and help because He is your true friend.

Prayer Idea: “Dear God, thank You for being my friend. Help me to talk to You like I would with my best friend, and to remember that You love me always. I’m glad You are always with me. Amen.”

WEEK 1: KNOWING GOD

Day 2: God Loves Me

“But God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.” Romans 5:8

Today, we learn about the amazing love God has for each one of us. God’s love is special because He loves us no matter what, even when we make mistakes or do things wrong. This verse reminds us that God showed His love in the biggest way by sending Jesus to die for us, even when we didn’t deserve it. Today, take a moment to thank God for loving you so much, for loving you no matter what, and always being there for you.

Remember, you are deeply loved by God, and that love can give you strength and joy every day.

Prayer Idea: “Dear God, thank You for loving me no matter what. Thank You for sending Jesus because of Your great love. Help me to feel Your love in my heart and to love others like You love me. Amen.”

Day 3: God Listens

“Then you will call on me and come and pray to me, and I will listen to you.” Jeremiah 29:12

Today’s verse reminds us of something very special: God always listens when we talk to Him. No matter what we say, whether it’s a happy thought, a worry, or a question, God wants to hear it from our hearts.

Take time today to ask God for something you really want or need. Trust that He hears you and wants to help you in the best way.

Prayer Idea: “Dear God, thank You for always listening to me. Today, I want to share what’s on my heart. Please hear my prayer and help me with what I need. Amen.”

Day 4: God Forgives

"If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness." 1 John 1:9

Today's verse teaches us a wonderful truth about God's forgiveness. Sometimes we make mistakes or do things we know aren't right. When that happens, it's important to say sorry, not just to others but to God too. Forgiveness is a gift from God that shows how much He loves us. It means we don't have to carry around guilt or shame because God takes those away. When you say sorry and thank God for forgiving you, you are growing closer to Him and learning to live in His love.

Prayer Idea: "Dear God, I'm sorry for the wrong things I've done. Thank You for forgiving me and making my heart clean again. Help me to forgive others like You forgive me. Amen."

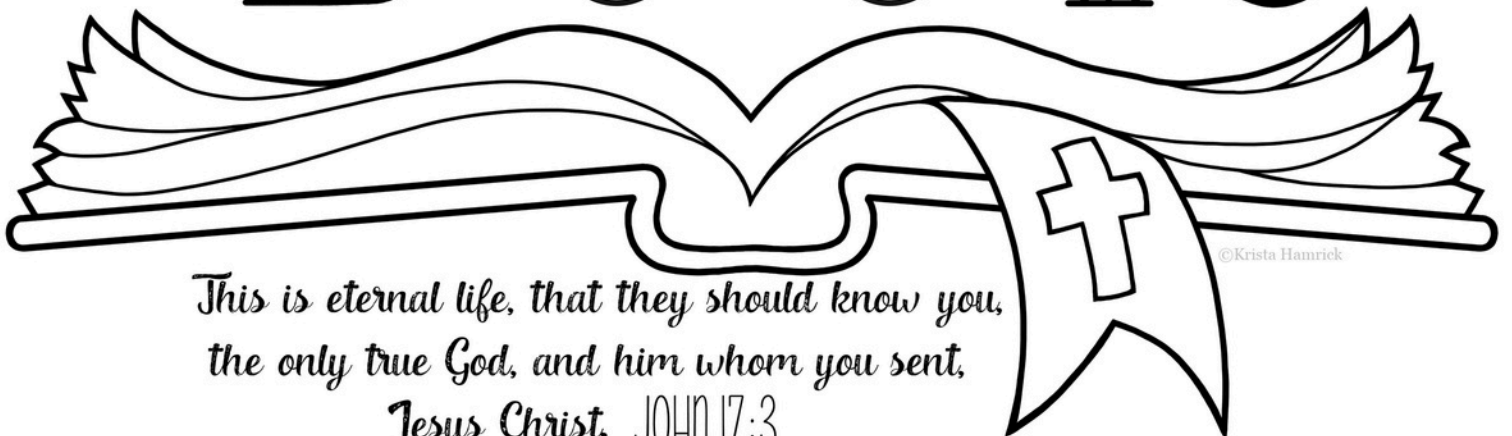

Day 5: God Is Close

“The Lord is near to all who call on Him, to all who call on Him in truth.” Psalm 145:18

Today’s verse reminds us that God is always near us, ready to listen whenever we pray or call out to Him. No matter where you are or what you’re feeling, God is right beside you, close enough to hear every whisper of your heart. Today, take a moment to quietly whisper a prayer to God. Tell Him about your day, your feelings, or anything on your mind, knowing He is right there with you, listening with love.

Prayer Idea: “Dear God, thank You for being so close to me. I know You hear my prayers, even when I whisper them. Help me to remember that You are always near and that I can talk to You anytime. Amen.”

Day 6: God Made Me

"I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; your works are wonderful; I know that full well." Psalm 139:14

Today's verse reminds us that God made each one of us in a very special way. You are unique and amazing because God created you with care and love. From your smile to your talents, from your kindness to your creativity, every part of you shows how wonderful God's work is. Today, take some time to thank God for the special ways He made you. Celebrate your talents, your personality, and the things that make you unique. Remember, you are wonderfully made by God's loving hands.

Prayer Idea: "Dear God, thank You for making me special and wonderful. Thank You for creating me just the way I am. Help me to remember that I am loved and valued because You made me. Amen."

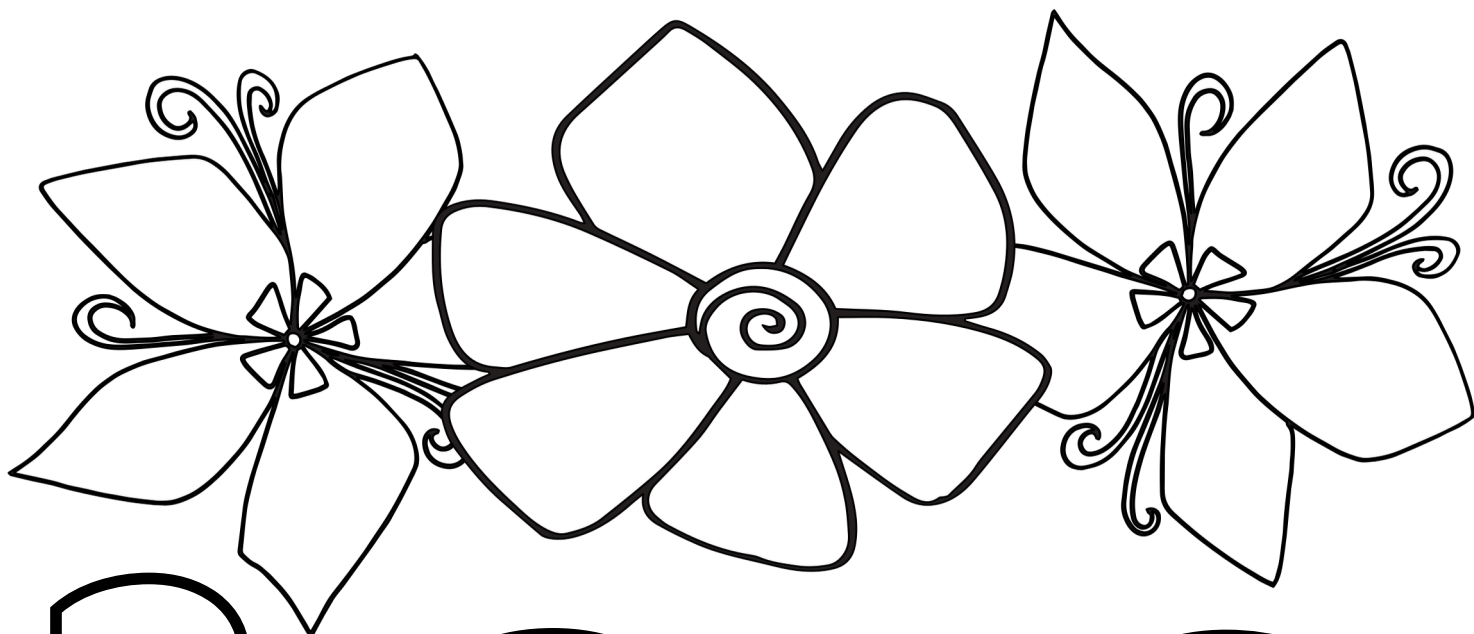
WEEK 1: KNOWING GOD

Day 7: God Is Always With Me

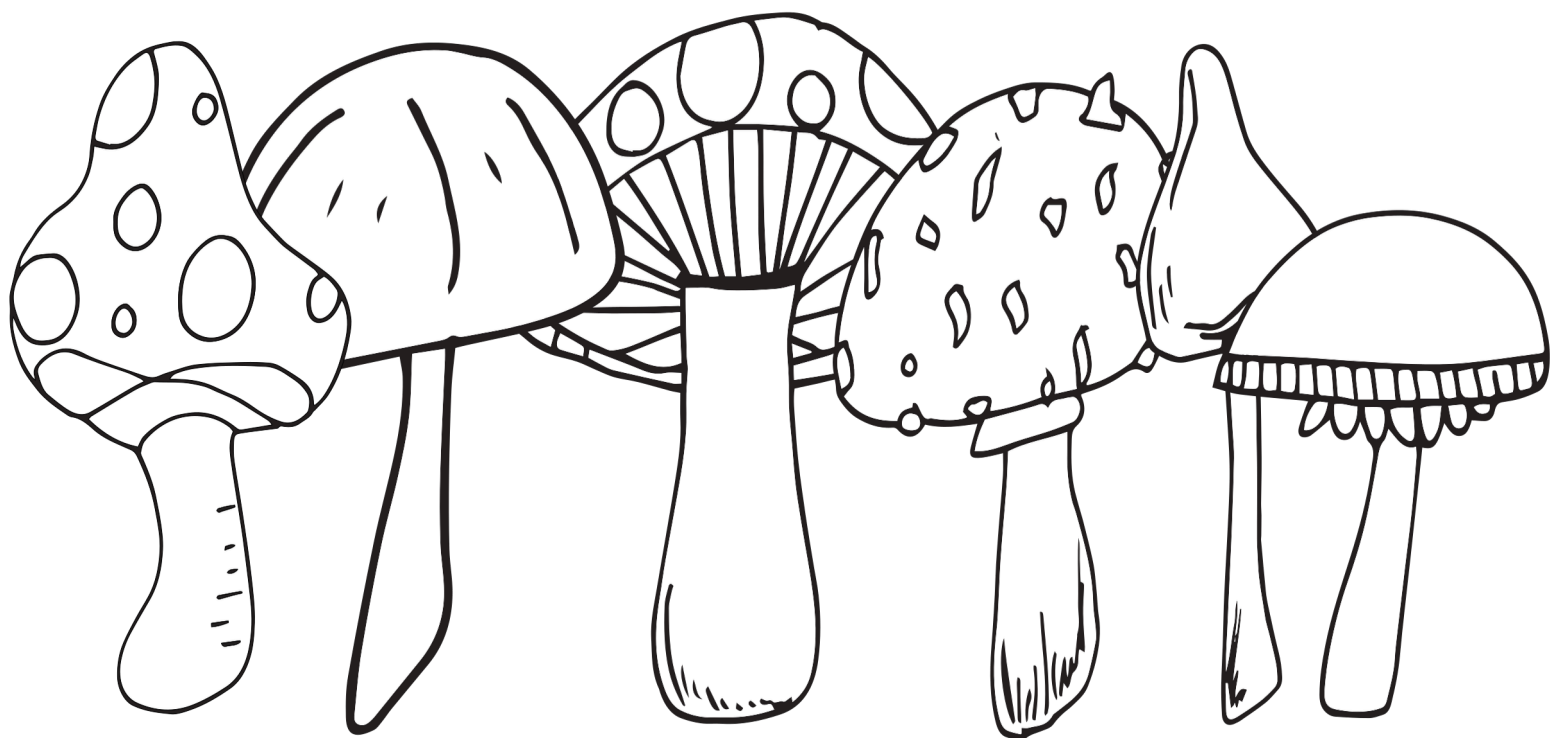
“Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go.” Joshua 1:9

Today’s verse reminds us that we are never alone. No matter where we are or what we face, God is always right beside us, giving us strength and courage. Sometimes life can feel scary or hard, but God promises to be with us and help us be brave. When you feel nervous about something—like a new school, making friends, or trying something new—remember that God is your greatest helper. You can pray and ask Him to give you courage, so you don’t have to be afraid.

Prayer Idea: “Dear God, thank You for always being with me. Please help me to be strong and brave today. When I feel scared or worried, remind me that You are by my side and that I can trust You. Amen.”

Day 8: Pray for Family

“Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. ‘Honor your father and mother,’ which is the first commandment with a promise, ‘so that it may go well with you and that you may enjoy long life on the earth.’” Ephesians 6:1-3

Today’s verse reminds us how important family is to God. Our parents, brothers, sisters, grandparents, and other family members love us and take care of us. God asks us to respect, obey, and honor them because they want what’s best for us. So today, take a moment to pray for your parents, siblings, grandparents, and anyone else in your family. Thank God for your family and ask Him to watch over them.

Prayer Idea: “Dear God, thank You for my family. Please help my parents, siblings, and grandparents to be healthy and happy. Help us to love and take care of each other every day. Thank You for always loving us. Amen.”

Day 9: Pray for Friends

“A friend loves at all times, and a brother is born for a time of adversity.” Proverbs 17:17

Today’s verse reminds us how special friends are. True friends love and support each other not only when things are easy and fun but also when times are hard. They stand by each other through good days and tough days. So today, think about your friends—maybe someone who needs a little extra love or encouragement—and pray for them. Thank God for the gift of friendship and ask Him to help you be a good friend, too.

Prayer Idea: “Dear God, thank You for giving me friends who love me. Please help my friends to be happy and safe. Help me to be a kind and loving friend to them, just like You are to me. Amen.”

Day 10: Pray for Teachers & Leaders

“I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercession, and thanksgiving be made for all people— for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness.” 1 Timothy 2:1-2

Today, we focus on praying for the special people who help guide us—our teachers, coaches, pastors, and leaders. These are the people who teach us, encourage us, and help us grow in many ways. Just like we need friends and family to support us, they need our prayers to have strength, wisdom, and patience as they lead and care for others. Today, take a moment to thank God for the teachers and leaders in your life, and ask Him to bless and guide them every day.

Prayer Idea: “Dear God, thank You for my teachers, coaches, and pastors. Please help them to be wise, patient, and loving. Give them strength when things are hard and help them lead in a way that honors You. Thank You for using them to help me grow. Amen.”

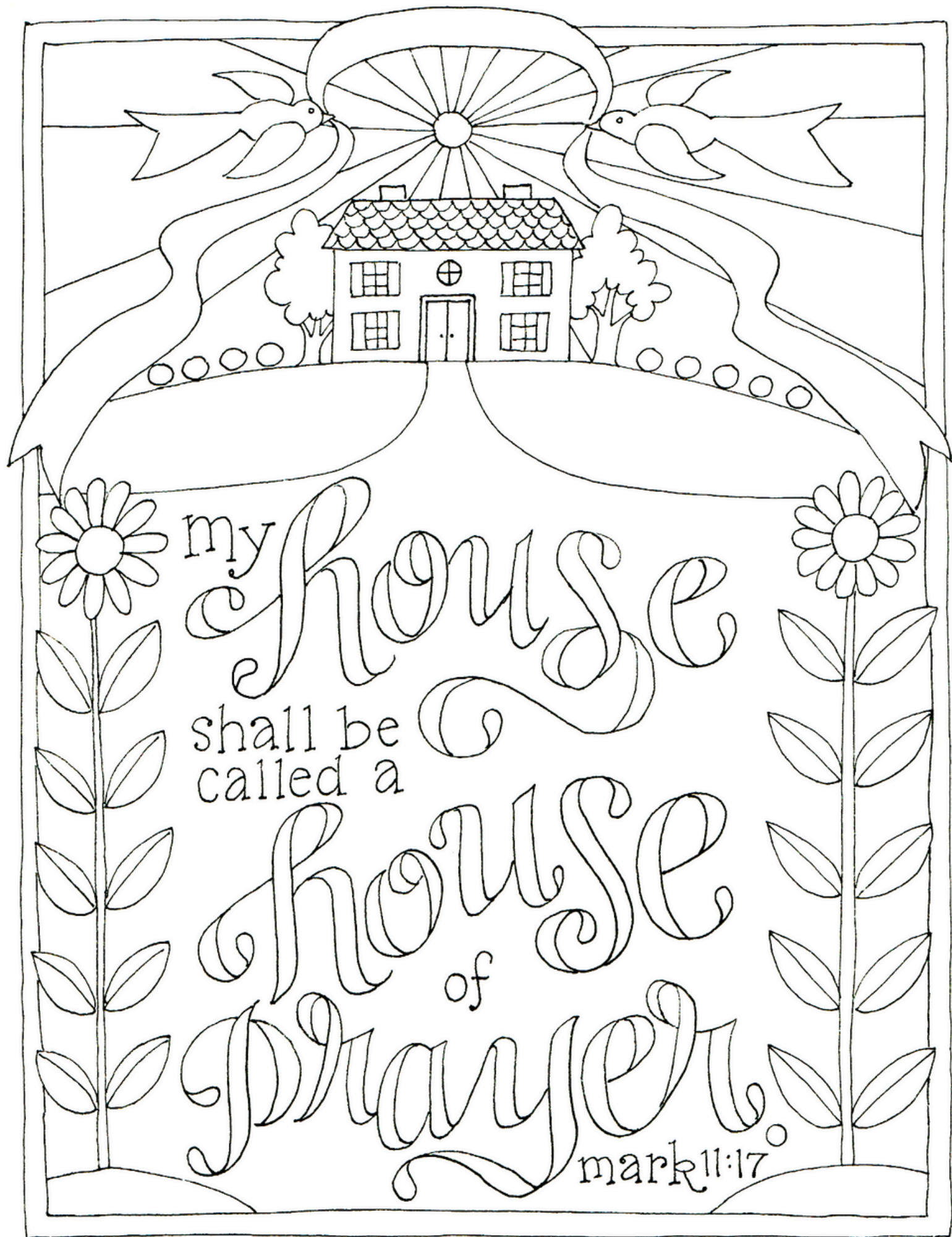
WEEK 2: PRAYING FOR OTHERS

Day 11: Pray for Your Church

“And I tell you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church, and the gates of Hades will not overcome it.” Matthew 16:18

Today, we learn that God has built His church on a strong foundation, and He promises that nothing can stop it. The church is not just a building—it’s a family of people who love God and help each other grow. This includes your kids ministry, pastors, teachers, and everyone who works hard to make church a special place. Today, think about your church family and pray for the kids ministry, your pastors, and everyone involved. Ask God to guide them and keep them safe.

Prayer Idea: “Dear God, thank You for my church and all the people who help me learn about You. Please bless my pastors, teachers, and everyone who works in kids ministry. Help us all to love You more and to take care of each other. Keep our church strong and safe. Amen.”

Day 12: Pray for People Who Are Sick

“Is anyone among you sick? Let them call the elders of the church to pray over them and anoint them with oil in the name of the Lord. And the prayer offered in faith will make the sick person well; the Lord will raise them up.” James 5:14-15

Today, we learn that God cares deeply about people who are sick or hurting. When someone feels unwell, it's important to pray and ask God to bring healing and comfort. Praying for those who are sick shows love and kindness, and it invites God's power to help them feel better. Today, think about someone you know who isn't feeling well—maybe a friend, family member, or someone in your church—and pray for God to heal them and help them feel better.

Prayer Idea: “Dear God, please help [name or people who are sick] to get better. Please heal their body and give them comfort and peace. Thank You for always being with us and loving us. Amen.”

Day 13: Pray for Your Community

*“But seek the welfare of the city where I have sent you into exile, and pray to the Lord on its behalf, for in its welfare you will find your welfare.”
Jeremiah 29:7*

Today, we learn that God cares about the place where we live—our neighborhoods, towns, and cities. He wants us to pray for our community and ask Him to make it a good, safe, and happy place for everyone. When we pray for our community, we also help ourselves because when our neighborhood is safe and happy, we all benefit and feel more at peace. God wants us to love not just ourselves, but also the people around us and the place we live.

Prayer Idea: “Dear God, please bless my neighborhood and city. Help the people who live here be kind and caring. Keep us safe and help us work together to make our community a happy place. Thank You for loving us all. Amen.”

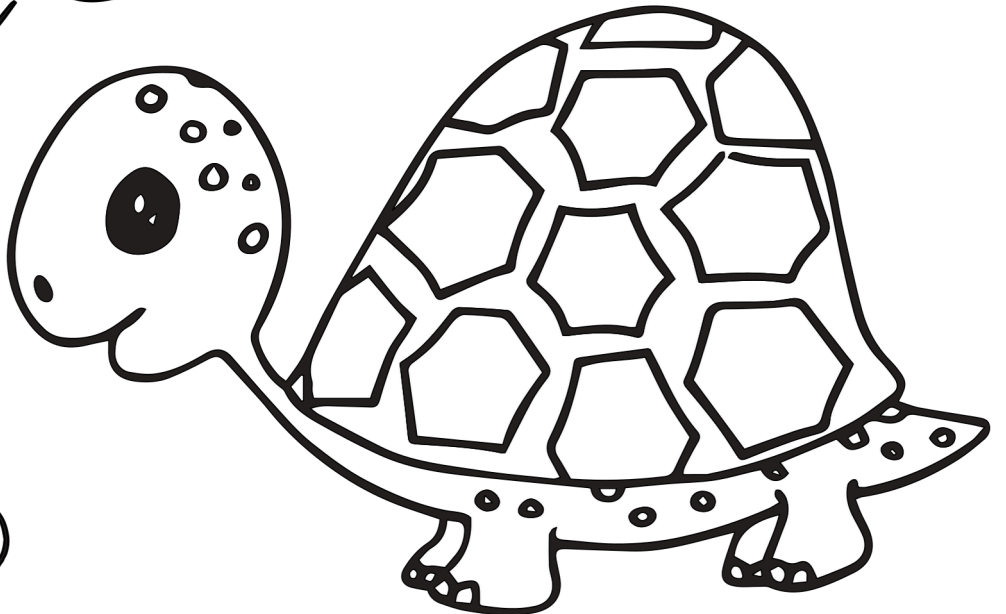
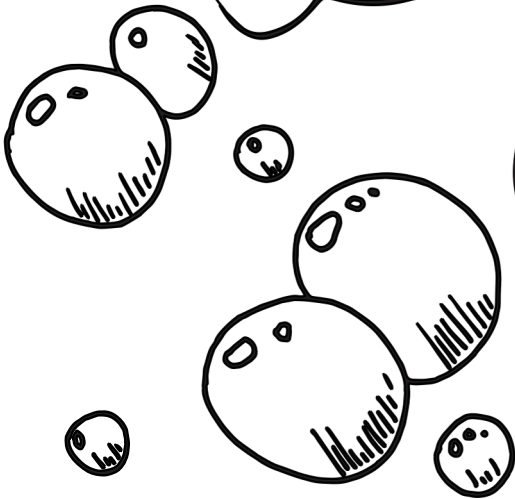
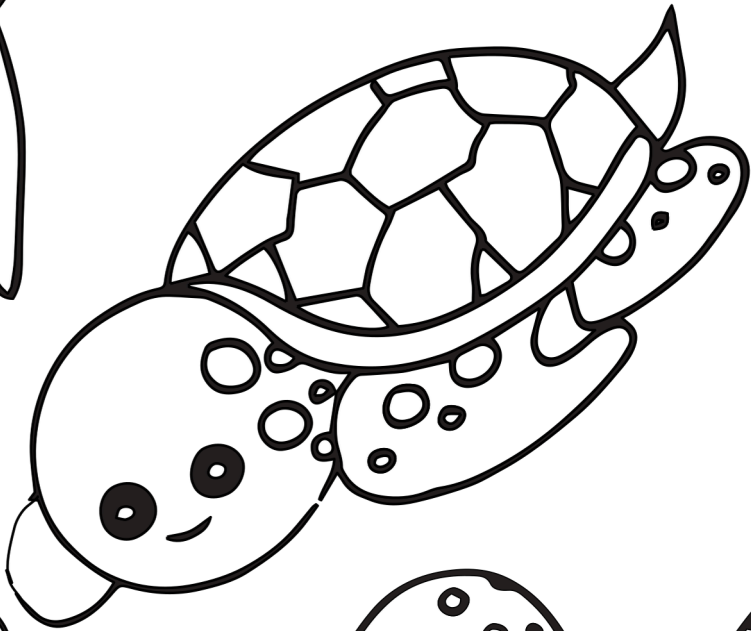
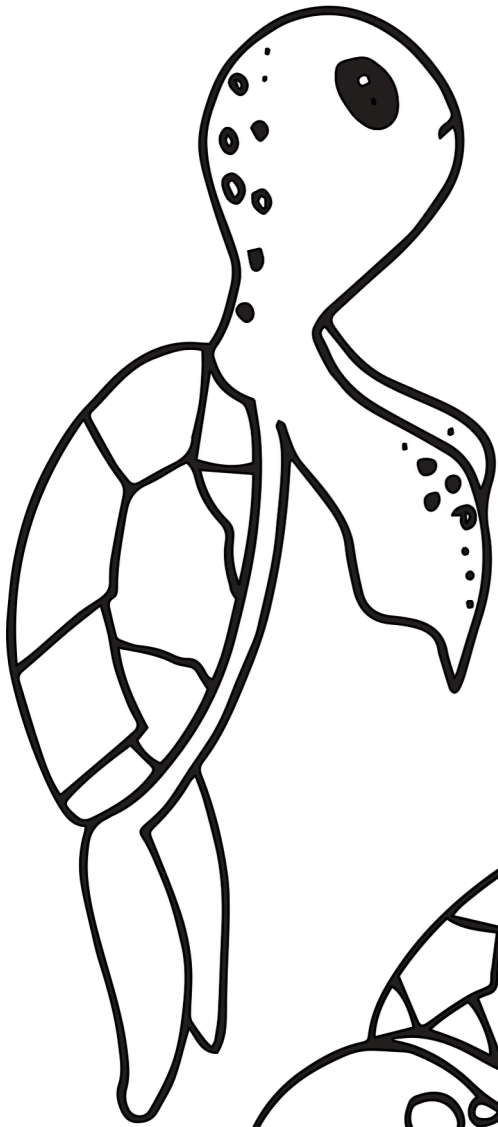
Day 14: Pray for the World

Day 15: Be Kind

“Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.” Ephesians 4:32

Today’s verse teaches us how important it is to be kind and caring toward others. Kindness means thinking about other people’s feelings and choosing to do good things for them—even when it’s not always easy. God wants us to be kind because He is kind to us. When we are kind, we help make the world a happier, gentler place. Small acts like sharing, listening, helping, or saying something nice can brighten someone’s day and show God’s love. So today, look for ways you can be kind to friends, family, classmates, or even someone you don’t know very well. Kindness is a way to show God’s love in action.

Prayer Idea: “Dear God, thank You for being kind and forgiving to me. Help me to be kind and compassionate to others, and to forgive just like You forgive me. Teach me to show Your love every day through my actions. Amen.”

Day 16: Be Thankful

“Give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God’s will for you in Christ Jesus.” 1 Thessalonians 5:18

Today we’re reminded how important it is to say “thank You” to God—not just when things are going great, but in every situation. Being thankful helps us focus on the good things God is doing in our lives, even on hard days. One great way to show our thankfulness is to make a thank-you list. It can be simple! Just write or say the things you’re thankful for—big and small. This helps our hearts stay joyful and reminds us of God’s goodness every day.

Prayer Idea: “Dear God, thank You for all the good things You’ve given me. Thank You for my family, my friends, my home, and Your love. Help me to always be thankful, no matter what. Amen.”

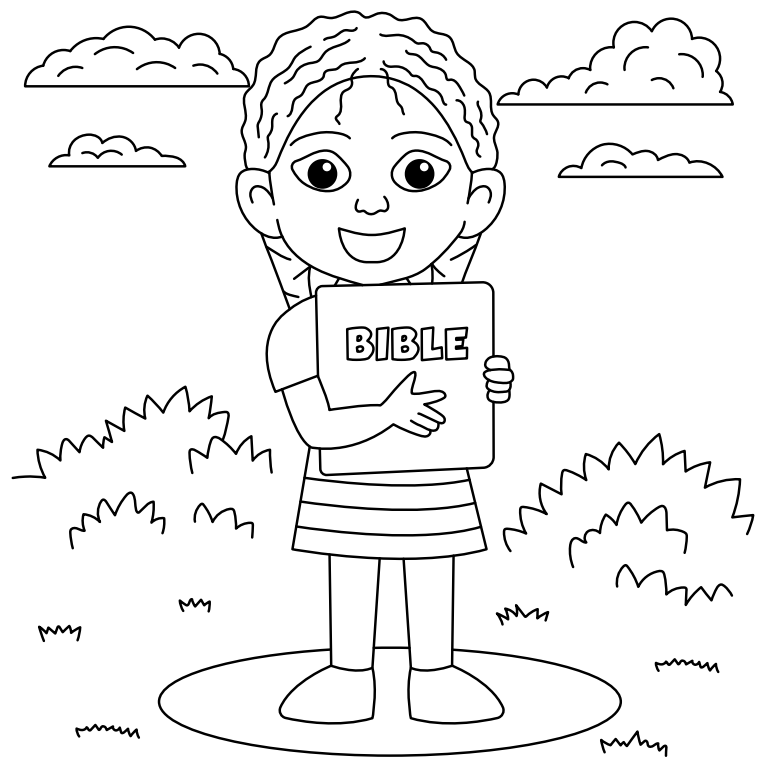
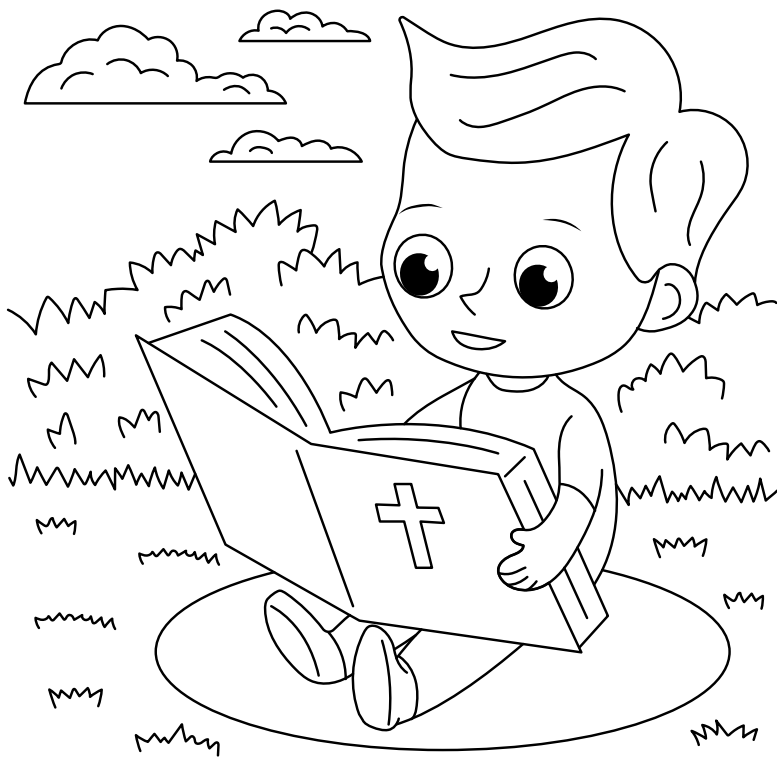
WEEK 3: LIVING LIKE JESUS

Day 17: Be Honest

“The Lord detests lying lips, but He delights in people who are trustworthy.” Proverbs 12:22

Today’s verse teaches us how much God values honesty. Telling the truth is sometimes hard—especially when we’re afraid we might get in trouble or hurt someone’s feelings. But being honest shows that we are trustworthy, and it pleases God. If you ever feel tempted to lie or hide the truth, stop and ask God for help. He will give you the courage to be honest and the peace that comes with doing the right thing.

Prayer Idea: “Dear God, help me to always tell the truth, even when it’s hard. I want to be someone who makes You proud. Give me strength to be honest and kind in everything I say and do. Amen.”

Day 18: Be Brave

“When I am afraid, I put my trust in You.” Psalm 56:3

Today’s verse reminds us that everyone feels scared sometimes—kids, grown-ups, and even people in the Bible! But the good news is that we don’t have to face our fears alone. God is always with us, and He gives us the courage we need when we feel afraid. So today, if something makes you nervous—like a test, a doctor’s visit, a new place, or speaking in front of others—talk to God about it. Ask Him to help you be strong and brave.

Prayer Idea: “Dear God, sometimes I feel scared. Please help me remember that You are always with me. Give me courage and help me to trust You no matter what. Thank You for making me brave. Amen.”

WEEK 3: LIVING LIKE JESUS

Day 19: Be a Helper

“Serve one another humbly in love.” Galatians 5:13

Today’s reminder is simple but powerful: God wants us to help others with a loving heart. Being a helper means looking for ways to serve—whether it’s holding the door for someone, sharing your toys, picking up trash, or comforting a friend who’s sad. So today, keep your eyes open! Is there someone at school, home, or church you can help? And once you help, take a moment to say a prayer for them too.

Prayer Idea: “Dear God, thank You for giving me chances to help others. Show me someone I can help today, and give me the courage and kindness to do it. I want to serve with love, just like Jesus. Amen.”

Day 20: Be a Light

“Let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven.” Matthew 5:16

Today’s verse reminds us that God wants us to be a light in the world. Just like a lamp brightens a dark room, our actions and words can show others the love and goodness of Jesus. When we choose to be kind, honest, helpful, and loving, people notice—and it helps them see what Jesus is like. So today, ask God to help you shine your light brightly. Pray that through your kindness, your words, and your actions, others will see Jesus and want to follow Him too.

Prayer Idea: “Dear God, please help me to shine my light for You. Help me to be kind, loving, and honest so that others can see Jesus in me. Use me to show Your love and make the world a brighter place. Amen.”

Day 21: God Has a Purpose for Me

“For I know the plans I have for you,” declares the Lord, “plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.” Jeremiah 29:11

Today, we celebrate a wonderful truth: God has a special plan just for you! He knows everything about your life and wants the best for you. Even when things feel confusing or scary, God’s plans are full of hope, love, and good things. So today, thank God for His amazing plans for your life. Trust that He will help you grow, learn, and shine in the ways He has planned just for you.

Prayer Idea: “Dear God, thank You for having big and wonderful plans for my life. Help me to trust You, even when I don’t understand everything. Please guide me and show me the way You want me to go. I’m excited for the future You have for me! Amen.”
