PASTOR'S MESSAGE FOR 2026

Psalm 4 will be our chapter for the New Year, with verse 3 as our focus:

"Know that the Lord has set apart the godly for Himself."

As we approach the New Year, I want to invite you to join me in several worthy endeavors.

First, I am inviting all of my Sheep to read through the Bible with me over the next two years. Yes, it will take two years—and that is intentional. I want us not only to read God's Word, but to understand it in its proper context. This plan will require reading only two to three chapters per day.

Here's the twist: for each chapter, you will read one corresponding paragraph from Warren W. Wiersbe's *With the Word Handbook*, which helps explain what you have just read. This small but powerful book has the potential to change your life as you read alongside Scripture. The assignment is short, manageable, and doable for all of us. I will explain more from the pulpit, and I will provide the Bible reading plan. This journey will be fun, educational, and spiritually enriching as we grow together in the Word. So—are you in?

Second, I am asking you to study Psalm 4. This psalm will be my prayer for WBC throughout the coming year. As we prepare for future steps—such as building a gym and possibly a new sanctuary—we will need everyone contributing, on some level, to the building fund.

As you read Psalm 4, I hope you understand that our ultimate goal as WBC is not physical buildings, prestige, or leaving a legacy for ourselves. My primary focus is the spiritual growth and health of my Sheep.

As you study this psalm, here are some themes I will be praying over for all of us: answered prayer, healing, God's grace, heart reflection, faithfulness, holiness, sanctification, proper preparation for worship, trusting God, God's favor, witnessing, joy, peace, and safety.
