# Nashville Rescue Mission

As of 2023, there

are over 2100 homeless persons in Davidson County. The lack of affordable housing is a significant cause of homelessness even in families with one or both parents working but not making enough money to meet their expenses. Thankfully, the Nashville Rescue Mission has been serving the homeless in Nashville for 70 years!

Two years ago, the women's campus was demolished to make way for a new Women & Children's

Campus which opened in January 2024. This new campus has increased housing capacity for women and children, enabled the facility to feed more people, and provided expansion of their worship services. The new campus provides the mothers and children a greater chance to thrive and break the cycle

by providing them with a safe environment, access to medical and mental health care, career education, job opportunities and substance use treatment. This allows them to plan for a better future and take them out of a shelter environment.

New Hope's group of volunteers was blessed to be able to serve dinner on Feb 5th, approximately one week after opening. For the last 13 years, New Hope has not only supported NRM financially, but has also been volunteering at the Nashville Rescue Mission, primarily the women's campus, serving dinner on the 1st Monday of each month. 


### A Book You Should Read
