Community Group Questions – Week of October 12th, 2025

Getting Started: Read this week's passage out loud & pray the Holy Spirit will help you understand. **Ice Breaker**: What are some metaphors we use about food? (For example: I'm stuffed.)

	<u>- Broans.</u>
1)	What are some things that hinder our thirst for God? What helps you conquer that?
2)	Why should we pay careful attention when the Bible says, "Jesus cried out?"
3)	Jesus tells us we come to God through Him. Yet many people who claim to be "Christian" believe that we get to Heaven by being a "good person." Why do you think that is?
4)	If someone asked you what it meant to be "thirsty for God?" How would you answer them?
5)	We said that Jesus called many people who rejected Him. Why should we still try to reach people who reject Jesus? How can we explain to people who think it's too late for them that Jesus often called people who rejected Him? (For example: The Apostle Paul)
6)	Read 1 Corinthians 6:19-20 out loud. What do we mean when we say the Holy Spirit indwells the Believer? How will that affect the way we live?
7)	Why do Christians often get tied up in disagreements, rather than the truth of scripture?
8)	If rivers of living water are flowing within you, what are some ways that can be lived out among people in your life and brothers and sisters in Christ?
9)	Was there anything you wanted to ask or say to the group this week?
10)Was there anything specific you think God wanted you to take away or change from this passage?
11	How can we pray for you in regard to what we studied this week? Other prayer requests are fine, but we are also looking for a specific prayer request for you in regard to this week's passage.
