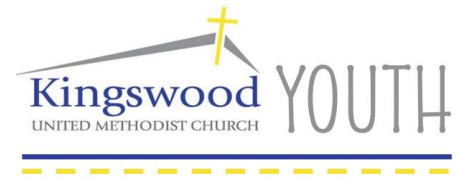


Youth Mission Trip Summer 2024

When: Sunday, July 14 to Saturday, July 20, 2024

Participant Cost: Depending on how many youth and/or adults from your family are participating, follow the cost breakdown below.

- \$375 per youth per week (for the first child)
- \$75 discount for each youth after the first, within the same family
 - For example:
 - Child 1= \$375
 - Child 2= \$300
 - Child 3= \$225
 - Child 4= \$150
- \$200 for adult volunteers

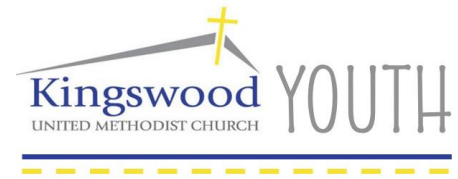
Payment Timeline: It is essential to secure our space that ASP has initial deposits by April 1, 2024. This is a fast turnaround but is necessary for ASP to determine our trip location.

- **A deposit of \$50 per person (all youth and adults no matter the discount rate) is due by April 1, 2024.**
- An additional \$175 per person (or \$100 for fourth child in family) is due by May 1, 2024.
- The final payment amount per person (varies depending on your specific rate listed above) is due by June 1, 2024.

Fundraising Plan:

- We are working on some fundraising ideas which will help to offset the cost for all participants.
- The total monies raised go towards transportation and any other extra expenses. The cost to you only includes the amount required by ASP.

Financial Support: We would like all youth to participate in this trip! If you would like to attend this year's mission trip but are unable to because of financial challenges, please contact Kate Lapetino to discuss our mission trip scholarships.

Cost Breakdown: The cost to attend ASP is \$375 per person. Kingswood and any fundraising efforts are what results in our reduced family costs, reduced adult volunteer costs, as well as the transportation costs. Scholarships are available through Kingswood UMC for families who have financial challenges that prohibit them from attending.

Overview of Important Dates (tentative—additional dates and information may be added)

- April 1, 2024= Initial deposit of \$50 per participant is due
- May 1, 2024= Second deposit of \$175 per participant is due (\$100 for fourth child)
- June 1, 2024= Remaining balance per participant is due
- June 23, 2024= Participant meeting to go over trip details at 12:00 pm @ BG campus
- July 7, 2024= Participant tie-dye fellowship event at 2:00 pm @ BG campus
- *Date TBD*= Send-off Sunday (happens usually 1-2 Sundays before trip at Sun. services)
- July 14, 2024= Departure to West Virginia (location and times coming soon)
- July 20, 2024= Return from West Virginia (details and times coming soon)
