

Dear Friends,

Judy and I continue to offer our deepest gratitude and appreciation for your many expressions of love and support in these recent weeks—for cards, food, care of Tess, and most of all, your prayers and encouragement. Earlier this week (4/8) I finished radiation therapy and rang the bell as a marker of this chapter completed. I'm scheduled for a scan in several weeks and will then begin a six-month round of chemo that will take us to October. I am thankful that to this point I don't have many side effects and that the brain fog is slowly beginning to dissipate.

I've been meditating on the phrase, "But God." Despite this vicious disease, the Lord is still sovereign and all about life and hope: "...like sheep they are appointed for Sheol... but God will ransom my soul from the power of Sheol, for he will receive me" (Ps 49:14-15). The Lord is faithful and carrying us through this experience. Judy writes, "I am learning more and more about the power of prayer and to expect surprises that are gifts from God."
