Dear College First family,

It was truly a thrill to share with you on **Vision Sunday.** If you missed it, check out the audio podcast or watch the video. God is on the move and we've all been invited to love, equip, and send for His glory. The FYI is filled with many ways to "get in the game," but I want to highlight a few here.

We are having a **fundraiser lunch** this Sunday at 12:15 PM in the Fellowship Hall (under the sanctuary) to support the Berachah Prayer Hall in India. This growing congregation was started by the father of Simeon Joseph, our Associate Director of Next Gen Ministries. The menu will feature (not spicy) Indian food. The suggested donation is \$15/adults and \$5/children.

Upward Flag Football and Cheerleading have begun. We are serving around 1000 people on Saturday mornings, about 45% of whom are unchurched. Praise God! We have prayed for God to build bridges between us and the community and God has certainly answered. We have 247 kids ready to hear about Jesus, but we need vour help. You are invited to

- serve as a Chaplain during practices on Thursday nights. These are pre-written devotions that can be read or summarized. Typically chaplains meet with one or two teams at a time.
- set up and tear down on Saturday mornings. Set up begins around 7:20 AM and usually takes around an hour. Tear down is after the final game and begins at 12:15 and usually only takes about 45
- greet/host on Saturdays either between 8:30-10:30 AM or 10:30 AM to12:30 PM. Greeters make families and guests feel welcome as they arrive and answer questions.

What Is Upward Sports?

Upward Sports is a non-profit that shares gospel and Jesus while teaching kids the power of positive sportsmanship. Upward has been doing this for well over 20 years. According to Upward.org, "We view sport through the lens of a greater purpose - which means the impact can extend far beyond the game. Sports break down barriers and create a powerful catalyst for churches to build relationships and serve others. All children deserve opportunities to be active, learn and have fun! That's why we value co-creating new and different play experiences with church partners to welcome and reach all children. Based on Luke 2:52 'Jesus grew in wisdom and stature and in favor with God and man.' Our experiences are designed to equip churches to engage the whole athlete – mind, body, spirit and soul." Upwards games consist of Flag Football players, cheer leaders, coaches, greeters, team chaplains, etc.

A Note From Faith

Five years ago I still worked as an assistant Children's director for College First, specifically for the Winebrenner campus. It was right after COVID and we were trying to think of how we could specifically reach families and children in the community. It was truly a God-ordained discussion as I approached Pastor Brandon about this idea, he said he had some other individuals that brought up sports ministry as being an avenue that we have never explored. And therefore, after discussing locations, looking into organizations to partner with, researching what our community could benefit from, and possibly how to use the amazing resource that is the University of Findlay, Upward Flag Football was born! We began with 100 football players and 25 cheerleaders that first year- and it has grown every year! We are passionate about the Word of God and get excited when we hear testimonies of who is hearing the messages being spoken through devotionals to the players, cheerleaders, families, and even the coaches! Through our registration process we have seen a steady percentage of around 45% of kids/families reporting they do not have a church affiliation. Our goal has never to been one to make sure all of these individuals come to College First, but we have a passion that all individuals walk away hearing and experiencing the Word of God at each point of the ministry that is Upward Flag Football at College First. Upward Flag Football is an incredible bridge to our community through the use of sports.

What Opportunities Are Available?

Upward games and practices are going on now. And we need **MANY** volunteers to help out....we have well over 200+ kids involved in Upward this season! We need **YOU** to help bridge the gap for our kiddos and families in several different ways:

- **Team Chaplains:** We are seeking several individuals to be team chaplains- this means 2-3 people coming to our practices to read a simple devotion (which we will provide). These devotions are just a couple minutes long, but they are an integral part in spreading the Word of God to our kiddos.
- Set up/tear down crew: We are looking for 4 individuals to help us set up at 5:30 on Thursday evenings, and/or setting up/tearing down on Saturday mornings around 7:20 am or 12:45pm for about 45 minutes.
- Hosts: we love to have 2 people at the field gate on Saturday mornings from 8:30-10:30 or 10:30-12:30 to welcome families, players, cheerleaders and direct them on where to go. This is a wonderful way to show God's love to the family, friends, and participants of this year's Upward Flag Football season.

This is a wonderful opportunity to help us continue to dedicate this season to showing God's love to the Upward community, equipping the participants and their families with God's message of salvation, and sending God's family into the community to further His Kingdom.




International Student Ministry Donations Needed
