What Is Upward Sports?

Upward Sports is a non-profit that shares gospel and Jesus while teaching kids the power of positive sportsmanship. Upward has been doing this for well over 20 years. According to Upward.org, "We view sport through the lens of a greater purpose - which means the impact can extend far beyond the game. Sports break down barriers and create a powerful catalyst for churches to build relationships and serve others. All children deserve opportunities to be active, learn and have fun! That's why we value co-creating new and different play experiences with church partners to welcome and reach all children. Based on Luke 2:52 'Jesus grew in wisdom and stature and in favor with God and man.' Our experiences are designed to equip churches to engage the whole athlete – mind, body, spirit and soul." Upwards games consist of Flag Football players, cheer leaders, coaches, greeters, team chaplains, etc.

A Note From Faith

Five years ago I still worked as an assistant Children's director for College First, specifically for the Winebrenner campus. It was right after COVID and we were trying to think of how we could specifically reach families and children in the community. It was truly a God-ordained discussion as I approached Pastor Brandon about this idea, he said he had some other individuals that brought up sports ministry as being an avenue that we have never explored. And therefore, after discussing locations, looking into organizations to partner with, researching what our community could benefit from, and possibly how to use the amazing resource that is the University of Findlay, Upward Flag Football was born! We began with 100 football players and 25 cheerleaders that first year- and it has grown every year! We are passionate about the Word of God and get excited when we hear testimonies of who is hearing the messages being spoken through devotionals to the players, cheerleaders, families, and even the coaches! Through our registration process we have seen a steady percentage of around 45% of kids/families reporting they do not have a church affiliation. Our goal has never to been one to make sure all of these individuals come to College First, but we have a passion that all individuals walk away hearing and experiencing the Word of God at each point of the ministry that is Upward Flag Football at College First. Upward Flag Football is an incredible bridge to our community through the use of sports.

What Opportunities Are Available?

Upward games and practices are going on now. And we need **MANY** volunteers to help out....we have well over 200+ kids involved in Upward this season! We need **YOU** to help bridge the gap for our kiddos and families in several different ways:

- **Team Chaplains:** We are seeking several individuals to be team chaplains- this means 2-3 people coming to our practices to read a simple devotion (which we will provide). These devotions are just a couple minutes long, but they are an integral part in spreading the Word of God to our kiddos.
- **Set up/tear down crew:** We are looking for 4 individuals to help us set up at 5:30 on Thursday evenings, and/or setting up/tearing down on Saturday mornings around 7:20 am or 12:45pm for about 45 minutes.
- Hosts: we love to have 2 people at the field gate on Saturday mornings from 8:30-10:30 or 10:30-12:30 to welcome families, players, cheerleaders and direct them on where to go. This is a wonderful way to show God's love to the family, friends, and participants of this year's Upward Flag Football season.




