

GETTING STARTED

What stood out to you most from the message or the clip from The CHOSEN? Why?

REFLECTION/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. The man had been stuck for 38 years. What does "being stuck" look like in your life now?
- 2. Why do you think Jesus asked the man, 'Do you want to be made well?' What does that question stir in you?
- 3. Can you think of a time when you weren't ready to get better, even if you said you were? Why is desire so essential to transformation?
- 4. The man had excuses, but Jesus invited him to action. What excuse is Jesus asking you to drop? What step feels scary—but necessary—right now?
- 5. Who are the people or voices influencing your mindset most these days? Are they pulling you up or keeping your stuck?
- 6. Jesus told the man to take his mat with him. What's something from your story—once a burden—that God is now using as a testimony?
- 7. What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?

PRAYER: Lord Jesus, thank you for reaching down to this man who was "stuck"—physically, emotionally, and spiritually. You saw through his excuses to the heart of the question. Help us to always be open to your healing work in our hearts. May we see and know and recognize your work, in our lives and those around us. In the name of Christ, we pray, Amen.

GOING DEEPER: Read John 5:1-18. How did the religious leaders respond to this miracle? What was the result for Jesus of healing the man? How did his response to the Jewish leaders only heighten their opposition? What does it mean to "take care of your miracle"?

"Inside the city, near the Sheep Gate, was the pool of Bethesda, with five covered porches. Crowds of sick people—blind, lame, paralyzed—lay on the porches. One of the men lying there had been sick for thirty-eight years. When Jesus saw him and knew he had been ill for a long time, he asked him, Would you like to get well?" 'I can't, sir,' the sick man said, 'for I have no one to put me into the pool when the water bubbles up. Someone else always gets there ahead of me.' Jesus told him, 'Stand up, pick up your mat, and walk!' Instantly, the man was healed!"
