Jesus the Intercessor – 10/19/2025 Reflection Questions

1. What does the word “*intercessor*” mean in Biblical terms? How is Jesus’ intercession different from prayer in general?
2. What is the most quoted Old Testament verse in the New Testament? How does seeing Jesus seated on the throne help us in our prayer life?
3. Why does humanity need an intercessor between us and God and what does it mean that Jesus “always lives to make intercession” for us?
4. Comment on the quote from Charles Spurgeon “I have learned to kiss the wave that slams me into the Rock of Ages.”
5. How does Hebrews 9:24 describe where Jesus intercedes for humanity and why that location matters, considering He is still both 100% man and 100% God?
6. How does Isaiah 53:12 (“He made intercession for the transgressors”) prophetically point to Christ’s intercession?
7. Jesus is interceding for you in heaven and the Holy Spirit is interceding for you in your heart. Comment on this statement: “You are not inviting God into your prayer meeting. He is inviting you into His.”
8. How does knowing Jesus intercedes for you affect your confidence before God and how should this truth change the way you respond to guilt or condemnation?
9. How does Christ’s intercession give us assurance of salvation?
10. In Luke 22:32, Jesus tells Peter that He has prayed for Peter in regards to his sifting of the devil. How can you remind yourself daily that Jesus is praying for you?
11. If interceding is standing in the shoes of another and considering their issues as your own, in what ways can interceding for others reflect Jesus’ character?
