- 1. Do you personally have a positive or negative association with the concept of "being religious"?
- 2. How did the analogy of cutting 8 foot-long board relate to measuring ourselves to previous Christian generations vs measuring ourselves to the original standard of Christianity?
- 3. What would be the difference between the Holy Spirit conforming believers to the image of "Jesus on way the cross" versus the image of "Jesus resurrected and glorified"? How does 1 John 4:17 speak to this?
- 4. Why were the apostles in the book of Acts repeatedly opposed by religious leaders in the different cities of the Greek and Roman world?
- 5. How does 40 religious leaders forming a conspiracy to murder Paul in Acts 23 demonstrate that zeal for religion can blind someone to relationship with God?
- 6. Comment on this statement, "The Bible, in the hands of the devil, is not true." Do you agree or disagree?
- 7. Discuss this statement, "When God regulates something, He is not necessarily endorsing it, but He is restraining the brokenness behind it."
- 8. What are some potential examples of Old Testament laws in the Bible that are more of a concession or accommodation as opposed to being God's perfect moral will?
- 9. How can a "spirit of religion" effect Christians today? How can Wellspring be on guard against it?
- 10. Although God hates divorce, what does it tell us if He still uses the metaphor for Himself in Jeremiah 3:8?
