- 6. What are some spiritual truths and realities that we will never experience without making a100% commitment to the Lord?
- 7. In John 6:35, Jesus states, "I am the bread of life. Whoever comes to Me will never go hungry, and whoever believes in Me will never be thirsty." What would you say to a person who has come to believe in Jesus but still hungers and thirsts for the things of the world?
- 8. What did you think of this statement that as a Christian, "I can live life as a celebration of being full rather than an act of desperation trying to get full"?
- 9. Why is the assumption that 'we can find our true self by what we accomplish and experience in life' not true?
