

## Easter - Jesus is the Risen King Reflection Questions 03/31/2024

- 1. Do you consider Easter weekend the most significant weekend in the Christian calendar? Why or why not?
- Over the years, what has the Easter holiday meant to you personally or to your family?
- 3. Romans 8:11 tells us that the same Spirit that raised Jesus from the dead now lives in us as believers. This is a staggering reality. What can it mean for us practically today?
- 4. Where have you experienced God's resurrection power in your life?
- 5. Discuss this statement: "We love Jesus' attributes but not His absolutes"?
- 6. What are some of the differences between living in a democracy and a kingdom ruled by a king?
- 7. In the kingdom of God, if we are not able to vote on things nor able to make changes to laws, what is so attractive about being a part of it?
- 8. Discuss this statement: "God's resurrection power gets activated to the degree that we have personally made Jesus our King."
- 9. King Charles of Great Britain became king the moment his mother died. However, he was not crowned king for another 8 months. How was this fact related to Jesus being our king?
- 10. God warned the king of Babylon that judgment was on the way. How much time elapsed before God carried out the punishment (see Daniel 4:29)? Why does God graciously give us time to repent (also see Rev. 2:21)?
- 11. What needed to happen in the life of the king of Babylon for his sanity to be restored to him?
- 12. Where are you personally with God this Easter?
  - a. Jesus is already my King
  - b. I want to begin a real relationship with Jesus as my King
  - c. I need to consider things a bit more
  - d. I don't intend to ever make Jesus my King
