- 1. Describe a time in your life when you felt stuck. How were you stuck and what steps did you take to get unstuck?
- 2. Regarding the six fundamental teachings listed in Hebrews 6:2, do you feel any these are not well understood by you?
 - i) Repentance from dead works
 - ii) Faith in God
 - iii) Instruction about baptisms
 - iv) Laying on of hands
 - v) Resurrection of the dead
 - vi) Eternal judgement
- 3. What steps can you practically take to better secure your foundation?
- 4. Hebrews 5:14 states: "Solid food is for the mature, those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil." Do you feel your level of discernment is where it needs to be? How have you sensed discernment in your life?
- 5. One way of getting unstuck is by pouring into others. Hebrews 5:12 states that "by this time you ought to be teachers." Do you have anyone in your life who you mentor or impart wisdom to?
- 6. Have you experienced a time when someone contributed to your spiritual development? How did that impact your spiritual journey?
- 7. Were you surprised to see the progression in the Apostle Paul's life regarding his transition from (in his words) (a) a called apostle to (b) the least of apostles to (c) the least of all God's people to (d) the foremost sinner of all? How can we explain this progression and what does it teach us?
- 8. Have you found it to be true in your own life that the more you mature spiritually, the more you grow in your dependence upon the Lord?
- 9. How can we practically grow in our dependence on Jesus?
