**Main thought:**

4. Discuss the significance of Amaziah bringing back the idols to Judah after defeating Edom.
5. What were the immediate and long-term consequences of Amaziah's defeat and the plundering of Jerusalem?
6. How can we apply the lessons of 2 Chronicles 25 to our current lives, especially regarding how we handle temptations, seek counsel, and maintain spiritual discipline?
7. What is a practical step you can take this week to ensure your heart remains fully committed to God and not just a superficial compliance with His will?
