Missions Moment

August Missions: Owatonna High School Husky Pantry

Last August, the Cornerstone Mission's Board highlighted the needs of homeless and transitional students at OHS. All the money donated to the "Globe" that month totaled \$903.27. We were able to donate that to the Husky Pantry, which has supplies and gift cards to help those in need.



Nancy Williams, OHS Social Worker, is in charge of the OHS Husky Pantry, which helps students and families in transition with some of their physical needs. The following is a description of the Husky Pantry from Nancy and how she uses it to help students.

The OHS Pantry is run solely by donations. Gift cards to local grocery stores or Walmart/Target are helpful so that I can purchase fresh items such as fruit, salad, yogurt, cheese, etc to send home with students. Some individuals or organizations give cash donations. I've also used the donated money to help a student get a haircut or purchase a used bike or SMART bus token so the student could get to and from a job after school.

We do not have a school fund specifically for this so the best way to donate is to give cash or purchase gift cards from Hy-Vee, Walmart, Cashwise, Aldi, Fareway, or Target.

I currently have over 20 OHS students accessing the OHS Husky Pantry every week for food, clothing, hygiene and school supplies. Donations are greatly needed and appreciated. Thanks so much for thinking of students at OHS who rely on our Husky Pantry for support! Sincerely, Nancy Williams

Nancy explained that she has very limited storage so cash donations and/or gift cards are the easiest way to help support this need in our community and specifically at OHS. You may place cash or a gift card in the Globe this month. Please make sure the dollar amount is noted on the gift card. Online giving to the Globe is also an option. We will make sure all donations are delivered to Nancy Williams at the end of the month.

Please continue to pray for our schools, students and staff in Owatonna, especially as they are getting ready for a new school year. Donating to the OHS Pantry is one small way we can show our support and Christ's love to them.




