September Missions: The Lighthouse of Southern Minnesota

The September Globe mission is The Lighthouse of Southern Minnesota. This is a new entity born from the merger of Rachel's Light and Hospitality House. Their mission is to provide comprehensive, inclusive, and compassionate services to those experiencing homelessness in the community.

After months of research, consideration and many discussions the merger was seen as a necessary step to streamline resources, reduce duplication, and better meet the need of the local homeless population. The merger will allow an expanded range of programming for families, single parents, and individuals.

Despite the merger the physical locations of Rachel's Light and Hospitality House will remain operational until the end of 2025 or early 2026 when they will move into their new facility as part of a collaborative transitional housing project to be set in the former Mayo Clinic building on Oak Avenue near the Fareway Grocery. This will provide space for children, couples, and entire families to be housed together and not be separated.

Their vision is to create a more collaborative and cohesive effort to combat homelessness in the region. To help them reach this vision contribute in the Globe generously this month.
