MATTHEW 3:13-17


Baptism of the Lord

Matthew 3:13-17 records the baptism of Jesus, marking the official beginning of His public ministry. Written by Matthew as part of his Gospel account, this passage captures a pivotal moment where Jesus travels from Galilee to the Jordan River to be baptized by John the Baptist. John's baptism of repentance calls people to a way of life that expresses commitment to God, yet Jesus, who was sinless, presents Himself for this baptism. John initially protests, recognizing Jesus' superiority and saying he needs to be baptized by Jesus instead. Jesus said to him in reply, "Allow it now, for thus it is fitting for us to fulfill all righteousness." Jesus was baptized to fulfill all righteousness, meaning Jesus came to live a law-obedient life, fulfilling the Old Covenant through perfect obedience to its commands, and also to identify with sinners as part of His redemptive mission.

The Ministry of John the Baptist

In those days John the Baptist came: Matthew introduces us to one of the fascinating characters of the New Testament. This was the John born to Zacharias and Elisabeth, whose miraculous birth to this too-old couple was announced, along with his call to be the forerunner of the Messiah, in Luke 1.

In those days: "It is a general term that reveals little chronologically but insists that the account is historical."


Church Office Hours Update

Carrying the Message of Hope and Recovery

Narcotics Anonymous (NA) is a global nonprofit fellowship dedicated to helping individuals recover from drug addiction. At the heart of NA's mission lies a powerful commitment to community outreach—reaching those who are suffering and offering them a pathway to freedom from active addiction. Through various outreach initiatives, NA ensures that no addict seeking recovery need ever face their struggle alone.

Public Information and Awareness

NA's outreach also includes public information efforts designed to educate communities about addiction and recovery. Local service committees provide factual information about the NA program to outside organizations, healthcare providers, court systems, and the general public. This educational component helps reduce stigma around addiction and ensures that when someone needs help, they know where to find it.

Many NA areas maintain helplines, websites, and meeting directories that make it easy for newcomers to locate meetings and connect with the fellowship. These resources are maintained by volunteers committed to making sure that anyone seeking recovery can quickly access support.
