
EXTRAVAGANT GENEROSITY JOHN 3:16-21

Expression of Your Heart

John 3:16-21 comes from Jesus' conversation Nicodemus, a Pharisee who came to Jesus seeking understanding about entering God's kingdom. Written by the apostle John as part of his Gospel account, this passage contains arguably the most famous verse in all of Scripture, often called "the gospel in a nutshell." John 3:16 has been termed as "the golden text of the Bible", "the gospel in a nutshell", and "everyman's text" because it captures the essence of the Christian message in a single statement. Jesus is an expression of God's indescribable love for "the world," meaning all of mankind, demonstrating that God's love extends beyond any single nation or group. The passage presents the core Christian teaching that God's motivation for sending Jesus was love, not condemnation, though it also soberly addresses the reality of judgment for those who reject the light.

Immeasurable Love, Unending Life

"How does one preach on a biblical text already known by virtually everyone in the world? What can one say that hasn't already been said? How do I prevent people from mentally checking out because of their frustration at having to listen to yet one more sermon on a passage they committed to memory decades ago?" Honestly, I don't know. I don't have a good answer.
