





who is this jesus? John 21:7-14 Liar

John 21:7-14 captures the remarkable post-resurrection encounter where Jesus revealed Himself to seven disciples at the Sea of Tiberias, providing both physical sustenance and spiritual encouragement. Written by the apostle John as an epilogue to his Gospel, this passage follows a night of fruitless fishing when the disciples had caught nothing. As soon as the net was filled with fish, John recognized that "it is the Lord." They hadn't immediately recognized Him before. This could be due to a combination of factors. When Simon Peter heard that it was the Lord, he tucked in his garment, for he was lightly clad, and jumped into the sea. Peter's immediate response shows his eagerness to be with Jesus, even putting on clothes before swimming to shore. Jesus provided for his disciples. They get to shore and he's already got breakfast cooking! There are a lot of parallels between Jesus' breakfast meal and John 6, where Jesus fed the five thousand.

Breakfast by the Sea

The expression, "By hook or by crook," you may be surprised to learn, originated from the 21st chapter of the Gospel of John. A hook is the symbol of a fisherman, while a crook is the symbol of a shepherd. Here then in this chapter are symbolized the two ministries of the church: fishing and shepherding. That is how the work of God goes forward.
