





worthy of god's call 2 thessalonians 1:1-4, 11-12 All Saints Sunday

2 Thessalonians 1:1-4, 11-12 is part of Paul's second letter to the church in Thessalonica, written shortly after his first letter to address ongoing concerns and provide encouragement. Composed by Paul along with Silvanus and Timothy, this passage opens with thanksgiving for the remarkable spiritual growth of the Thessalonian believers despite intense persecution. Paul implies the source of the Thessalonians' growing faith and love as well as steady perseverance is God himself, emphasizing that their spiritual progress is ultimately a work of divine grace. The Thessalonians met their persecutions and harsh trials with perseverance and resolute trust in God. Nothing moved them away from their confidence in God and their dependence on Him. As a result, Paul and his fellow missionaries boasted about the Thessalonians in their contacts with other churches.

2 Thessalonians 1:1-4, 11-12 Commentary

At first glance it may be tempting to think Paul is primarily praising the Christians in Thessalonica for their admirable response to their suffering for the faith. He begins, after all, by celebrating both how their "faith is growing more and more [hyperauxanei*], and how the love [agape]" they "have for one another is increasing [pleonazi]"
