
who is this jesus? John 20:24-31 Lord

John 20:24–31 records one of the most famous post-resurrection encounters, where Thomas transforms from skeptic to worshiper after meeting the risen Christ. Written by the apostle John as the conclusion to his Gospel, this passage addresses Thomas's absence during Jesus' first appearance to the disciples and his subsequent demand for physical proof of the resurrection. Thomas, like the others, had once vowed that he would die with the Lord, and like the others, had failed. After the Resurrection of Jesus, he had returned, and there was Jesus to meet him. What he wants is the strongest possible evidence that the pre-death Jesus is none other than the resurrected Jesus. That's what he wants. Now this is really a kind of faith that eschews gullibility.

The Aim of the Gospel

He assumed that the hotel doorman had told the driver of the carriage that they were to go to the train station. So when he got in, he simply said to the driver, "Drive fast."

Off they went. After a short while, Huxley, who was familiar with the area, realized that they were actually going in the opposite direction from the train station. He yelled to the driver, "Do you know where you're going?" Without looking back, the driver replied, "No, sir, but I'm driving very fast."


