the lord's prayer esther 4:15-17 Your's Will be Done

Esther 4:15-17 represents a pivotal moment in the Book of Esther, where Queen Esther makes a courageous decision that will determine the fate of her people. Written during the Jewish exile in Persia, this passage follows Mordecai's challenge to Esther to use her position to save the Jews from Haman's genocidal decree. Esther's decision to go before the king without an invitation symbolizes her deep courage and commitment to her people. It's a demonstration of her willingness to put her own life on the line for the greater good. The passage shows Esther's transformation from hesitant bystander to determined leader who recognizes her divine purpose. This narrative of Esther's courage illustrates the theme of providence and responsibility in the face of peril.

Esther 4 – Esther's Decision

When Mordecai learned all that had happened, he tore his clothes and put on sackcloth and ashes, and went out into the midst of the city. He cried out with a loud and bitter cry. He went as far as the front of the king's gate, for no one might enter the king's gate clothed with sackcloth. And in every province where the king's command and decree arrived, there was great mourning among the Jews, with fasting, weeping, and wailing; and many lay in sackcloth and ashes.
