JOHN 6:30-39

Daily Bread



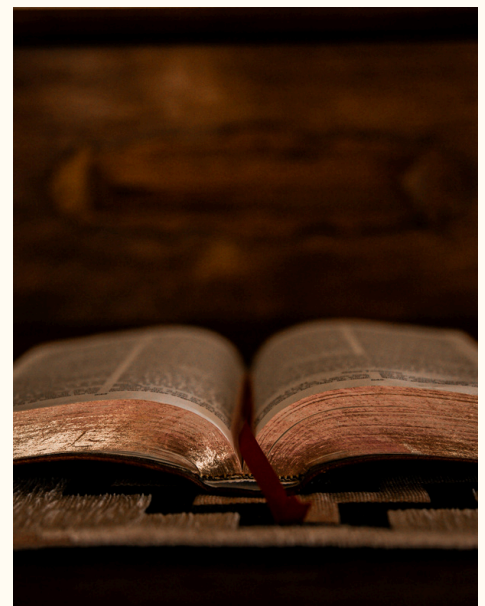

John 6:30-39 takes place shortly after Jesus' miraculous feeding of the five thousand, as crowds continue to seek Him out. Written by the apostle John, this passage captures Jesus' profound teaching about spiritual hunger and divine sustenance. The crowd demands a sign from Jesus, "What sign showest thou — What miracle dost thou work; that we may see and believe thee?" despite having just witnessed the extraordinary miracle of the loaves and fishes. In response, Jesus reveals Himself as the true bread from heaven, contrasting the temporary manna their ancestors ate in the wilderness with the eternal sustenance He offers. For Jesus to be the bread of life means that we will come to him as our satisfaction. We will not come to him to satisfy our desires. We will come to him because who he is satisfies.

Commentary on John 6:24-35

The bread that filled their stomachs now becomes the primary extended metaphor Jesus uses to stretch their understanding. The tricky part for the preacher is that s/he will be "driven" to deal with the bread image at every turn. Even as I write this article, the pull of "explaining" the bread metaphor is overwhelming.
