# STAGES OF FAITH GENESIS 12:10-20

#### Intuitive

Genesis 12:10-20 presents a troubling episode in Abraham's journey of faith, occurring shortly after his obedient departure from Haran. Written by Moses as part of the patriarchal narratives, this passage reveals how even great men of faith can stumble when faced with trials. In Genesis 12:10-20, we see what often happens in the life of faith: faith is often followed by famine, famine can lead us far from God, but God brings us back in his mercy and grace.

When severe famine strikes the Promised Land, Abraham chooses to go down to Egypt rather than trust God's provision in the land He had promised. Fearing for his life because of Sarai's beauty, Abraham instructs her to claim she is his sister rather than his wife. When Abraham moved to Egypt, the Egyptians saw that his wife was very beautiful and began to praise her to Pharaoh. Pharaoh, then, took her into his harem.

### The Faith of Abraham:

#### Abram and Sarai in Egypt

Lest we get the wrong impression about Abram from his initial obedience, Genesis 12:10-20 shows us that he was all too human, even in his redeemed state. It is so with us all. None is hero but Jesus. We are all, as Martin Luther said, simul justus et peccator, simultaneously just and sinner.


