
the LORD'S PRAYER COLOSSIANS 3:9-14 Forgive as We Forgive

Colossians 3:9-14 comes from Paul's letter to the church at Colossae, written while he was imprisoned. This passage follows Paul's instructions about setting minds on heavenly things and represents a practical guide for Christian transformation. Paul's reason believers should not lie to one another is found in the issue of identity. Those who put a trusting faith in Christ are new people who have died to sin and have become alive in Christ. The text contrasts the "old self" with its sinful practices against the "new self" that is being renewed in God's image. God has given us a new life in Christ Jesus. Our daily practice as believers must conform to our new position in Christ.

Colossians 3 – Put Off, Put On

Paul is clearly alluding to Genesis 1:27, where it is said that God created Adam in His own image. Nevertheless, now that the first Adam is regarded as the old man who should be put off and discarded, because now we are created after the image of the second Adam, Jesus Christ.

Walking Through Grief Together


