
STAGES OF FAITH GENESIS 18:1-15 Reflective

Genesis 18:1-15 presents the remarkable story of divine visitation where God appears to Abraham by the oaks of Mamre accompanied by two companions. Written by Moses as part of the patriarchal narratives, this passage showcases both extraordinary hospitality and the reaffirmation of God's impossible promise. Abraham was well acquainted with the LORD and would have instantly recognized Him, because the Lord had spoken and/or appeared to him many times before during their covenant relationship.

When Abraham sees the three visitors, he immediately runs to offer them hospitality, personally preparing an elaborate meal with Sarah's help. Though Abraham and Sarah hurried to prepare this meal for their visitors, it still took considerable time to make and serve the food. The sense is that Abraham and Sarah themselves did this work, instead of commanding servants to do it for them.

Genesis 18:1-15, Commentary

We love the story of Mary, but the story of Sarah is more like the story of our lives. On this second Sunday of Ordinary Time, as we begin the journey of everyday life with the God who has done great things for us, let's reflect on this experience so many of us have had—when the promises of God's salvation are so out of touch with the reality of your life that all you can do is laugh.
