# EDENIC IDEAL GENESIS 3:1-13 No Fear


Genesis 3:1-13 records the catastrophic event known as "the Fall," where humanity's innocence and perfect relationship with God was shattered through disobedience. Written by Moses as part of the foundational narrative of human nature and sin, this passage explains how evil entered God's perfect creation. At first, Adam and Eve lived with God in the Garden of Eden, but the serpent tempted them into eating the fruit from the tree of knowledge of good and evil, which God had forbidden.

Their fall begins with a talking serpent. Satan seems to have either taken possession of a serpent's body or assumed the form of a snake. He is described as the craftiest of all wild animals. The serpent's strategy involves questioning God's word, denying the consequences of sin, and promising godlike knowledge.

# Tempted to Fall - Genesis 3:1-13

When God created Adam and Eve, they were naked and unashamed (Gen. 2:25). They were comfortable with each other and innocent before God. Once they gave in to temptation, they became ashamed of their nakedness and tried to cover themselves and hide from God.
