Extravagant Generosity Relationships Are Matters of the Heart

Day 1: Loving as Christ Loves Reading: John 13:34-35

This doesn't happen overnight, but through consistent focus on Jesus and allowing His Spirit to work in us. Today, take some time to honestly assess your spiritual growth. Where have you seen progress in reflecting Christ's character? Where do you still struggle? Ask the Holy Spirit to continue His transforming work in you, making you more like Jesus in your thoughts, words, and actions. Remember, this is a lifelong journey - be patient with yourself and keep your eyes fixed on Christ.

Day 5: Living Witnesses of God's Love Reading: 1 John 4:7-12

As we grow in Christ's love, we become living witnesses to the world of God's transformative power. Our love for one another becomes a testament to our discipleship. Today, consider how your life reflects God's love to those around you. Are there ways you can be more intentional about demonstrating God's love in your daily interactions? Pray for opportunities to be a channel of God's love, especially to those who may be difficult to love. Remember, it's through our love for one another that the world will come to know the reality of God's love and the difference it makes in our lives.
