A MESSAGE FROM PASTOR DESI

There is a massive current of divine power—God's resurrection power—alive and active in the world today. The same Spirit that raised Jesus from the dead is still moving, still healing, still creating new possibilities. The question is: how do we tap into that power? How do we experience it in our daily lives, in our church, and in our community?

The answer, as the people of God have known throughout history, is prayer. Prayer is not just quiet words whispered before bed or before a meal. Prayer is a lifeline. It is a spark that, when placed in the hands of the Holy Spirit, has the power to set off a chain reaction of transformation.

Think of a stick of dynamite. By itself, it doesn't look like much. But when the fuse is lit, the power within is unleashed. Prayer is much the same. On the surface, it may feel small, ordinary, even routine. But when we pray with faith and expectancy, God ignites that prayer with Spirit-filled power—opening doors, healing hearts, and changing lives.


For the next four weeks we are participating in an intentional experiment called **Dynamite Prayer**. We will join together in worship, in small groups, and individually using the *Dynamite Prayer* guidebook. This journey is designed to help us move beyond safe, routine prayers and into bold, Spirit-empowered prayers that open us to God's new possibilities. You can get a copy of the guidebook electronically through your favorite e-book provider or the library, or you can pick up a paperback in the church office for \$10.

The good news is you don't need to be a "prayer expert" to take part. The 28-day guide offers short daily readings, a scripture passage, and a breakthrough prayer focus for each day. It's accessible, practical, and designed for real life. Whether you are brand new to prayer or have been praying for decades, this experiment is an opportunity to grow deeper, bolder, and more expectant.

Over the next four weeks of worship, we will dive into what Scripture teaches about prayer—how it has sustained the people of God through storms, empowered the early church, and fueled revival and renewal throughout history. And as we pray together, we will practice noticing the ways God is moving—through open doors, surprising answers, new relationships, and renewed strength.





Nursery Worker


Hi! I'm Krystle Lawson, and I'm really happy to be joining the church nursery team
