Project Transformation... more than just reading...friendships and fun!



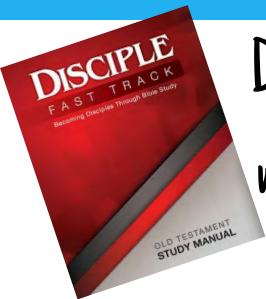

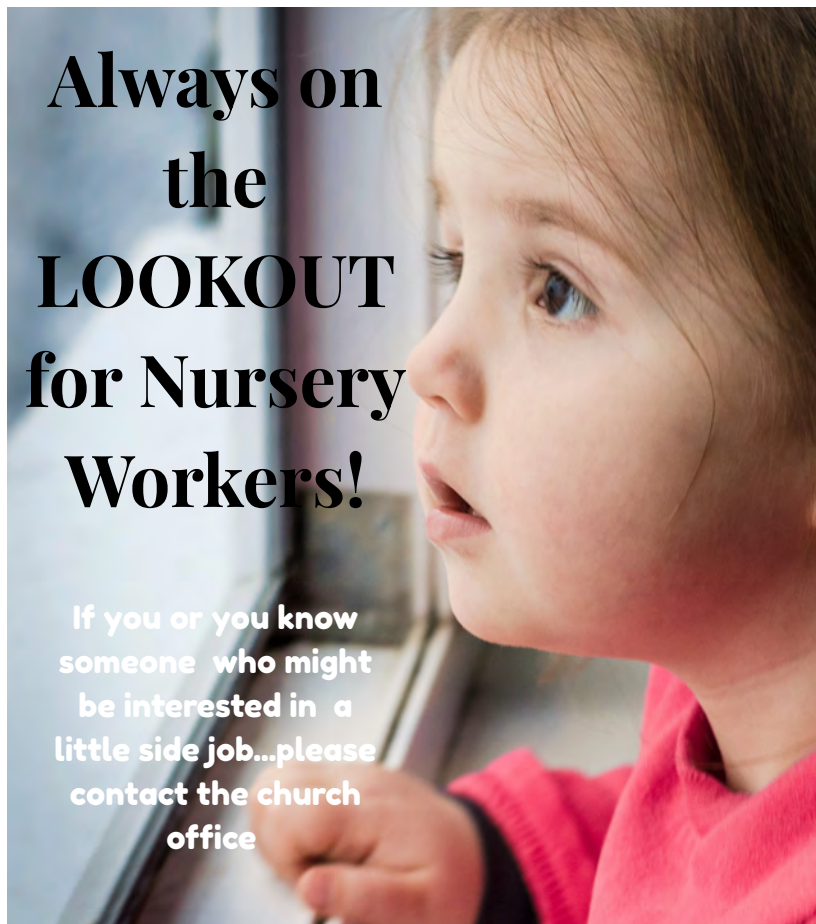

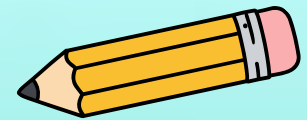
Teachers look Away... 🤔

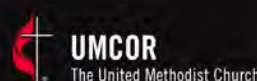
As devastation worsens from the recent catastrophic flooding in Central Texas, we have issued a solidarity grant to the Río Texas Conference of The United Methodist Church.
