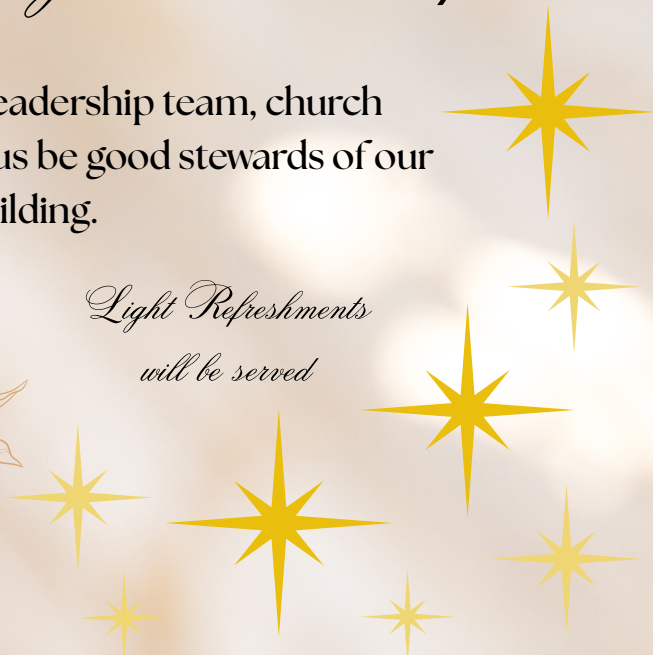
Kitchen to Say Grace Over

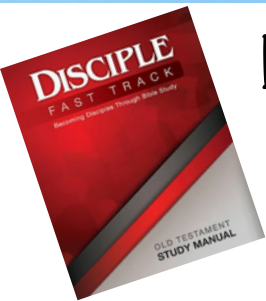

We will also celebrate the Leadership team, church members & donors who help us be good stewards of our church building.

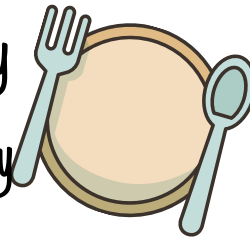

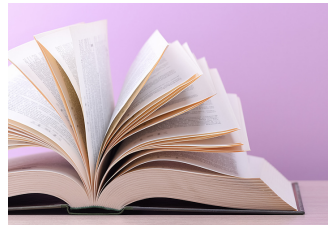

Rev. David Payne serves at First United Methodist Church Kerrville, TX just steps from the Guadalupe River. When the flooding began on July 4, he received an early morning call from the fire chief—and within minutes, the church was open, becoming a place of refuge for evacuees, some arriving with nothing but the clothes on their backs.

What followed was a week marked by heartbreak, service, and resilience. The church quickly became a shelter, and through their outreach ministry, Light on the Hill, they provided a haven for first responders. Though the stories coming out of Kerrville are heavy, the response of the community has been powerful.

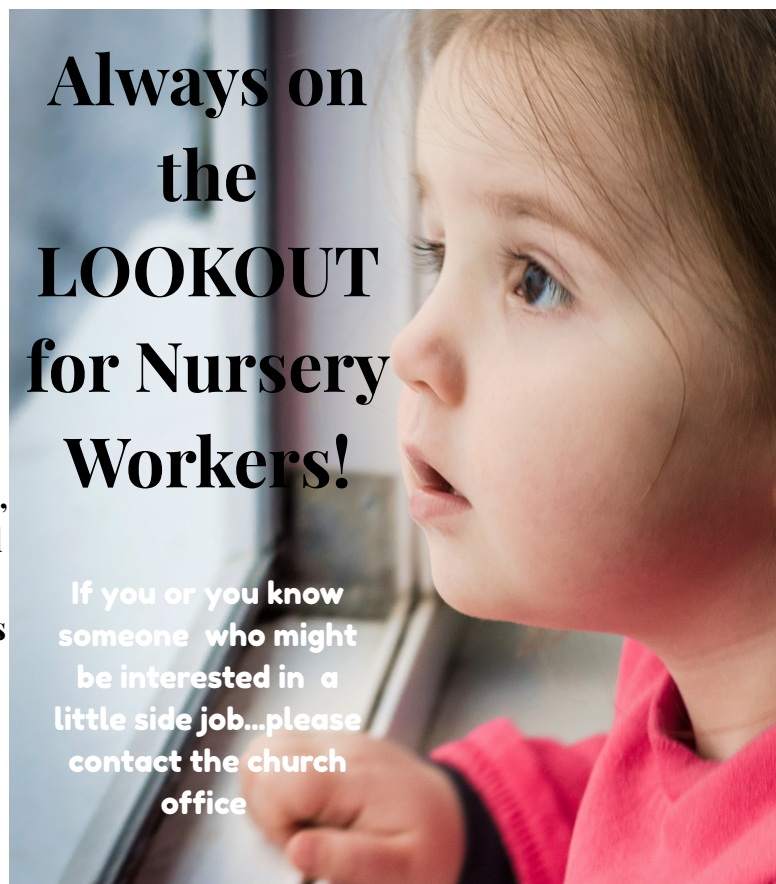
A Need by the Compassion Team:

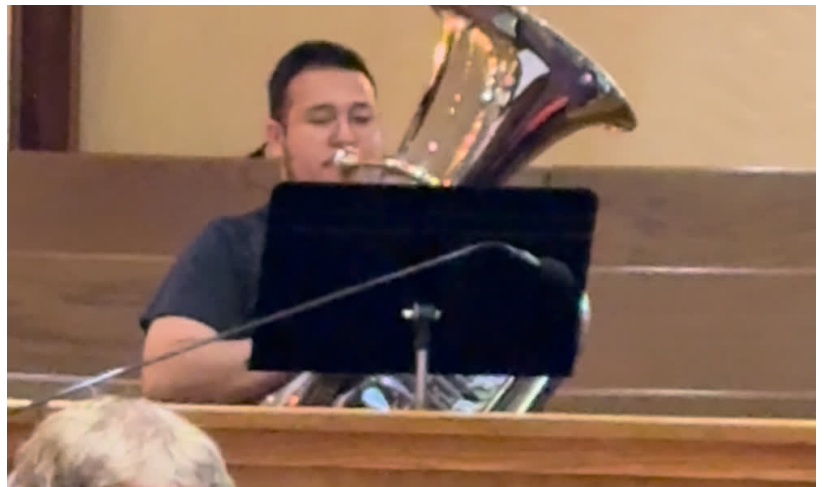
The carpet was cleaned last weekend and after Project Transformation finishes up Thursday the Fellowship Hall will be set-up for the dedication.

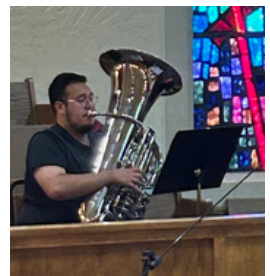
