Mission of the Month

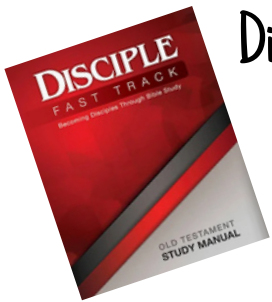
Due this Friday, August 1st to the church office

You do not have to purchase the backpack...we are just helping with the school supplies



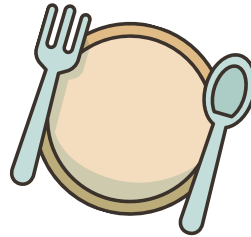
Happenings at St. Paul's

followed by the study for the adults



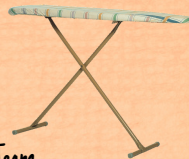
Compassion Team Needs

Desi and Ann put together a wonderful picture display of the BEFORE & AFTER of the kitchen. The display can be seen in the church foyer.



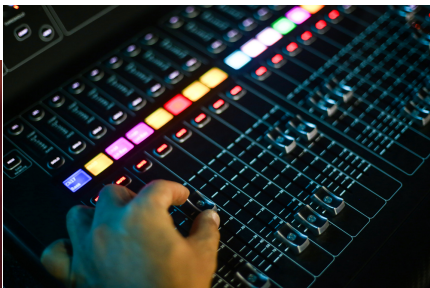
