This coming Sunday, October 5, we will join Christians around the globe in celebrating World Communion Sunday. This day is a powerful reminder that the table of Christ is bigger than any one congregation, denomination, culture, or nation. When we gather at the Lord's Table, we do not come alone—we come alongside believers from every time and place, from every language and tradition, from bustling cities to quiet villages, from large cathedrals to simple house churches. The practice of communion, instituted by Jesus on the night before his death, is already a unifying act. We break bread and share the cup to remember Christ's sacrifice, to give thanks for his grace, and to proclaim the hope of resurrection. On World Communion Sunday, that act of unity is magnified. Across time zones and continents, millions of Christians gather around tables—some ornate, some plain—yet all centered on the same Christ, who is the center of all that we are and all that we do. And we all will proclaim the mystery of faith together, "Christ has died, Christ is risen, Christ will come again!"

In a world often marked by division, fear, and uncertainty, this Sunday reminds us that what unites us is far greater than what divides us. As Paul wrote to the Corinthians, "Because there is one loaf, we, who are many, are one body, for we all share the one loaf" (1 Corinthians 10:17).

Here at Shawnee St. Paul's, we will celebrate with scripture, prayers, music, and proclamation, remembering that we are a vital part of that one body. As you receive the bread and the cup this week, take a moment to imagine the countless siblings in faith who are also sharing in this holy meal. Let it strengthen your spirit, widen your compassion, and deepen your sense of belonging in Christ's family.

Come to the table. There is a place for you.


