I simply asked Stephanie Currie to answer some questions so that I could spotlight her and the nursery program at St. Paul's. She sent me a full article to share! Stephanie gave me the gift of her words that I needed. So, meet our nursery coordinator and enjoy this gift she shared!



Hello, my name is Stephanie Currie! I'm the nursery coordinator here at St. Paul's; a new position for me. I'd like to think that I'm patient, flexible, with pretty good attention to detail, which might be one of the reasons Katie Tucker recommended me after stepping down from the position. My daughter Sawyer has probably talked to everyone at the church by now, she's not a shy girl! She's also kind and funny, a trait you'll find common among Curries (I hope). We're very humble as well.

Sawyer starts the 5th generation of Curries to be at the church! Many of you probably remember Bob Currie. He was my great uncle and a very active member of the church along with his wife, Carol. "But Jesus said, 'Let the little children come to me and do not hinder them, for to such belongs the kingdom of heaven." Matthew 19:14






