FROM THE PASTOR

THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD

The Feast of the Baptism of the Lord serves as a pivotal feast. It is the official end of the Christmas season, and it is the beginning of Ordinary Time.

In all four Gospels, our first encounter with the adult Jesus is at His Baptism. From the Finding of the Child Jesus, at twelve years old, until His Baptism, we have no biblical information. We presume that The Holy Family continued to live in Nazareth, that at some point Joseph passed away, that Jesus continued His father's carpentry business, at least for a while. There is speculation that at some point he left home, perhaps spending some time in the Dead Sea area with the Qumran community, and perhaps travelled around Judea, getting to know the cities and the concerns of the people.

Jesus' cousin, John the Baptist, began his active ministry, preaching and baptizing in the Jordan River. This was the point where the Hebrew people actually entered into The Promised Land. Through John's Baptism, the people were becoming New Israelites, starting over with God. Jesus came to John to be baptized. This was a problem, because John's was a Baptism involving repentance and the forgiveness of sins. Whose sins is Jesus repenting of?

John, recognizing the problem, says, "I should be baptized by you, and yet you are coming to me?" Jesus tells him to allow it for now to fulfill all righteousness. What John does not understand is that Jesus has come into this world to take our sins upon Himself. We see this most clearly in the Crucifixion, but even now, as He begins His ministry, He is showing that He has come into the world to take the sins of mankind onto Himself.

Baptism is not only the beginning of Jesus' ministry, it is also the beginning of our journey of discipleship, as we learn to follow Christ. In Baptism, we become Children of God, Disciples of Christ, and Temples of the Holy Spirit.

CONGRATULATIONS TO DIANE

After the 11:30 am Mass today, we will honor Diane Donathan for her forty years of service to Mother of God, and to our deaf community in particular, by her signing the Masses. She is a mainstay of Mother of God Church and has spent forty years assisting the hearing-impaired members of our parish to participate actively in the liturgy.

We are very grateful to Diane for being the blessing she has been to Mother of God Church.

THE GOSPEL OF SAINT MATTHEW

We are reading from the Gospel of Matthew throughout 2026. I want to give some general notes to help you read from that Gospel over the coming year.

Matthew and Luke are the only two Gospels that include an Infancy Narrative. Whereas, the Infancy Narrative in Luke is told through the eyes of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Matthew tells those stories through the eyes of Saint Joseph. Matthew begins the story with Joseph, having learned that Mary is pregnant, and planning to divorce her. The angel appears to Joseph in a dream and tells him not to be afraid to take Mary into his home as his wife, for the child is by The Holy Spirit. Joseph does so.

In Matthew's narrative, we learn of the story of The Magi and the slaughter of the innocents, and of the flight into Egypt. We see The Holy Family return to Nazareth, but still concerned about Herod's son.

It is a much darker presentation of the Infancy Narratives, hinting at the persecution this child will face, and His death upon the Cross.

SAINT ANTHONY, ABBOT

Saint Anthony the Great (also known as Saint Anthony, Abbot) lived in the Third century in Egypt. He will travel down to the deserts of Egypt in order to live the life of a hermit. This will last for many years, but eventually it became known that this very holy man was living there, and others came to him. They began living in caves in the region, under Anthony's leadership, forming the first monastery of the Church.

Anthony wrote a rule for his fellow monks to live by, and became known as the Father of Monks, even up to today.

Anthony's Feast Day is Saturday, January 17.




