

Week 2 A Conversation: John 3 May 4th, 2025

HIT THE HIGH NOTES:

- 1. Share your "John 3:16 testimony" (when you accepted Jesus)! Or, if you don't yet have one, maybe think on and pray about doing so! Talk to your group leader about it!
- 2. What was one take away from your experience at church on Sunday?

READ John 3:16-36 - Take time to mark up, think through, circle things you notice and then briefly discuss your *general* observations. Ask the Holy Spirit to give you wisdom and understanding as you interact with His Word.

Discussion:

- 1. What might be the most well-known verse in the Bible? Can anyone recite or read it?
- 2. What happens to anyone who believes in Him?
- 3. Why did God send His son? Why did He not send His son? (Verses 16-17)
- 4. What did men love instead of light? And why?
- 5. After Jesus's conversation with Nicodemus, where did He go and what did He do there?
- 6. What were the people arguing about?
- 7. Summarize what John the Baptist's reply/explanation was to them? (vs. 27-36)
- 8. Verse 33 says, "Whoever receives His testimony sets his seal to this, that God is true." A *seal* is like a *stamp of approval*. Is God's seal evident in your life? How?

Read: In preparation for next week, review Genesis. Read Numbers 27:1-11; 2 Timothy 1:5.

Pray: Father, thank you for the testimony you have written and continue to write in my life. Give me the opportunity to share your work in my life with others this week. Amen.

Go: Christianity is all about being an inviting culture. Who can you introduce Jesus to, this week?
