HIT THE HIGH NOTES:

READ Numbers 27: 1-11, Joshua 17:3-4 and 2 Timothy 1:5 Take time to mark up, think through, circle things you notice and then briefly discuss your *general* observations. Ask the Holy Spirit to give you wisdom and understanding as you interact with His Word.

Discussion:

Numbers 27: 1-11

- 1. Who was Zelophehad, how many daughters/sons did he have and what tribe was he from? (see verses 1-3)
- 2. What did the daughters ask for and why? (See verses 2-4)
- 3. What new rule was made and how was it used? (see verses 7-11)
- 4. What do you learn about God from this? (See verses 5-11)

Joshua 17:3-4

- 5. This passage mentions the daughters again, why?
- 6. What character traits do we learn about from the daughters/sisters?
- 7. What have you asked for or appealed to God for in your life?

2 Timothy 1:5

- 8. What women does Paul mention in his letter to Timothy and why does he talk about them?
- 9. What have you learned from these passages?

Read: In preparation for next week, Read John 15:1-15

Pray: Lord, we thank you for the mothers in our lives. Help each of us to be an example of Christ to those we influence and grow our relationship with God the Father. Amen
