

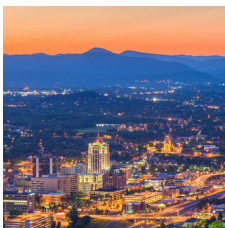

1. Know God.

At Parkway, we help people **know God** through worship services and personal relationship with Christ.

2. Find Freedom.

"[I pray]...that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened [focused and clear]."

Ephesians 1:17-18 NIV

At Parkway, we help people **find freedom** through discipleship and intentional study of God's truth (scripture).

3. Discover your Purpose.

We accomplish this through Sunday Worship, Wednesday Night learning, Groups, and Education support.

Provide Next Steps.

Some next steps people can take (in no particular order) include: Salvation, Baptism, New Friends Party, Equip, Membership, Dream Team, Groups, Freedom Group, One on One Discipleship, Leadership, and Mobilization.

Invite and Grow.

Inviting should always be easy and natural. All of us should feel comfortable inviting others to Parkway. We will equip every person with what they need in order to invite guests. People in our world want to come to church. And people will come to church if we invite them.

Not only do we want to invite new people to our church, we also want to invite our people into leadership. The goal is to develop a culture of "Come with me, learn from me, do with me, let me watch you do, go and invite someone to do it with you."

Invest Our Resources.

God honors what we plant. We will continually ask 'what is the best way to use this for the kingdom?' It is important to understand that we want our church environment to be welcoming and excellent, but it is not here just to be looked at.

We bless our people, but we don't waste God's money. We forecast, we report, we audit, and we are accountable. Most importantly, we pray for more resources so that we can expand our kingdom work.

FROM PASTOR DUSTIN, LEAD PASTOR

A PLAN FOR 2025 AND THE NEXT 5 YEARS

God is leading us to advance his Kingdom here in the Roanoke Valley and beyond – all the way to the ends of the earth. In the past 5 years, 35 years, and 100 years, God has given us a foundation to build on. I believe that foundation is a launching pad. The numeric and metric goals discussed below are a representation of reasonable expectations so that we can be held accountable to the growth principles we believe in as a church. However, our God is a God of increase and multiplication. These numbers represent our efforts but do not limit the power of God to pour out ‘exceedingly and abundantly above all that we ask or think...’ (Eph. 3:20) on our church as we seek him wholeheartedly with our ‘cups up’.

We desire to invest all that he is asking us to so that we may see these things take place. Our desires prompted by our faith (2 Thess. 1:11) exist (not exclusively) in six categories: Life Change, Congregation, Engagement, Finances, Education, and Kingdom Building. Here are some metrics as we look ahead to the next year and five years as we seek God’s blessing on our efforts.

LIFE CHANGE

We expect God to move in the hearts of people, saving them, freeing them from addiction and habitual sin, giving them a purpose in life, and empowering them by the Holy Spirit to produce fruit. Here is what we are praying for:
