Small Group Discussion Guide

Sermon Title: Christ or Chaos?

Text: Romans 5:12–21



Warm Up (Engage the Group)

- When you were a kid, what's a choice you made that had bigger consequences than you expected?
- Why do you think we often underestimate the impact of our choices?



Know It (Digging into the Word)

Read Romans 5:12-21 together.

- 1. What does Paul say Adam brought into the world through sin? (v. 12–14)
- 2. What does Paul say Christ brings instead? (v. 15–21)
- 3. Why do you think Paul contrasts Adam and Christ so strongly here?
- 4. How do verses 18–19 summarize the gospel in contrast to the effects of Adam's sin?



Share It (Personal Reflection & Discussion)

- 1. When you look at the world today, where do you see the effects of Adam (sin, condemnation, and death) most clearly?
- 2. How have you personally experienced the "chaos" of sin's effects in your own life or family?
- 3. On the flip side, where have you experienced the life and freedom that comes from Christ's righteousness?
- 4. Why is it hard at times to believe that Christ's gift really outweighs the brokenness of sin?



Live It (Application & Challenge)

- 1. In practical terms, what does it look like to choose "Christ" instead of "chaos" in your daily life this week?
- 2. How can our group encourage one another to live in the reality of Christ's righteousness and life rather than slipping back into guilt and shame?
- 3. Who in your life needs to hear that there's a better way—*Christ instead of chaos*—and how can you share that truth with them this week?



Prayer Time

- Thank God that in Christ you have righteousness, justification, and life.
- Confess the areas where you've been living under chaos rather than Christ.
- Ask God to help you walk in freedom and boldness, and to be a witness to others about the hope of the gospel.
