ACTION STEP

Make time this week for a quiet moment with God. Ask him to calm your thoughts and feelings.

Play a song of worship and then turn off your phone or anything that might distract you.

Then, do these six steps including the The Personal Assessment Tool.

PRAYER

Ask how you can pray for one another this week. Then, close in prayer, mentioning each request and person before the Lord. This prayer of cleansing may help you...

Heavenly Father, I admit that I don't like feeling like I need to confess. So, I'll start by confessing my own pride. It's hard to admit my sins. Lord, I know that I have plenty of areas in my own heart that need your presence, forgiveness and healing. Teach me to release these to you so that I can be cleansed in those areas, replacing my sinful desires with desires that please you instead. I admit that I chase after earthly substitutes for your goodness instead of being filled with you. Help me to make time to do these steps. Fill me with your love, forgiveness, and cleansing. Amen

Finish by reciting The Lord's Prayer:

Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.
Give us today our daily bread.
And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors.
And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one.
For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever.
Amen." — Matthew 6:9-13 NIV
